Mission Tables & Donation Cards

Visit the Mission Tables to get more information about our Local & Global Mission partners. If you wish to directly support a mission partner, complete the donation card at your place setting and drop it in one of the donation jars on the Mission Tables. To donate by credit card, find a volunteer with an iPad. Undesignated donations will go to the Mission General Fund.

Silent Auction

Silent Auction tables are grouped by color: Yellow, Blue, Green & Red.

- To bid on a Silent Auction item place your bid number on the appropriate bid sheet.
- You may increase the bid only by the indicated, pre-determined amount. You may bid as many times as you like.
- **OR** you can skip the bidding and purchase it at the *"Buy It Now"* price at the bottom of the bid sheet.
- We are offering a few fabulous parties! Each party can accommodate a set number of guests. Ticket prices are set. Sign up to purchase a place at the table! Space is limited and prices are not negotiable. If you sign up in one of the available spaces, you win!
- Bidding on the Silent Auction tables will close according to the Schedule of Events (see page 2).

Live Auction - Fund a Need

Tonight we are offering several opportunities to help fund various needs from our wonderful Global & Local mission partners. We'll highlight the different mission partners and give you the opportunity to raise your paddle to financially support these needs. Checkout Process

- At the end of the night, you will receive an email with your amount due. You may scan your QR code, visit the link associated with your bid number, or go to a checkout table to have a volunteer check your balance due. If your receipt is blank or your balance due is \$0, that means you did not win any Silent or Live Auction items. If you bid on something, please check to see if you won before you leave.
- There are four checkout tables in each corner of the Family Life Center. Go to any table to pay your balance and you will be instructed where to pick up your item(s).
- We accept cash, check, or credit card for payment. You will receive a receipt of your tax-deductible donation upon checkout.
- Drawing Prize and Door Prize winners will be posted on the screens.

How Fundraiser Monies Are Used

All proceeds are split between Global (2/3) and Local (1/3) Mission Outreach Funds. These committees then determine how to disperse to our mission partners.
