Small Group Questions Week of July 20, 2025

**Icebreaker:** What's one of your favorite memories from a camp, retreat, or close-knit community experience? When was a time someone "showed up" for you in a way that made a big impact?

## **Discussion Questions:**

1. Read Acts 2:42-47 aloud together.

What words or phrases stand out to you in this passage? What does it say about how the early church lived together and worshiped together?

- 2. Verse 42 says they were "devoted" to fellowship. What do you think it means to be devoted to relationships—not just friendly or polite, but committed?
- 3. The early church shared meals, prayed, worshiped, and supported one another.
  - Which of those practices comes naturally for you?
  - Which one do you find hardest to live out—and why?
- 4. Who in your life has helped you grow spiritually simply by being present? What did they do that made a difference?
- 5. Where are you tempted to "go it alone" in your faith right now? What's one way you can invite others into that space?
- 6. What's one step you can take this week to move toward deeper community?
