**Icebreaker:**

*Share about a childhood friend you had. Are you still in touch with them?*

**Discussion Questions:**

1. Read together: Psalm 90.

2. Psalm 90 is a reminder that God is eternal (He has no beginning and no end). When you think of God’s eternity, what phrases, definitions, or pictures come to mind?

How would you describe something that is to some degree unknowable?

3. Scriptures like Psalm 90 invite us to restore a sense of awe and wonder concerning the goodness, greatness, and grandeur of God. What practical steps can you take to think of God in this way?

How can your small group support you in this endeavor?

4. Read together: Romans 5:6-8, Ephesians 2:8-10, and John 3:16.

5. The grand story of the New Testament is that while God is completely sovereign and bigger than we can imagine, he sent Jesus to invite us into a relationship with Him. As you think about the stories of Jesus, which ones stand out most clearly about Jesus inviting us into a relationship?

6. God made us in his image (Genesis 1:27; Matthew 22:15-22). He is relational, and so are we! How can your small group dive deeper into authentic, warm, and lasting Christ-centered friendships?

7. Outside of your small group, how can you dive deeper into authentic, warm, and lasting Christ-centered friendships?
