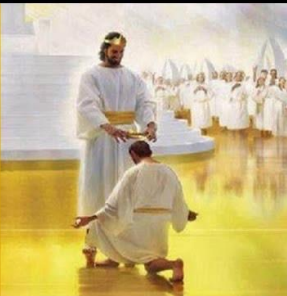

On a Scale from 1-10 . . . How much of a “people pleaser” are you? What can be the positive side of “People Pleasing”? How can it get you into trouble? Explain.

Look at 1 Timothy 5:19,20; James 3:1 Why are/will leaders be held to a higher level of scrutiny both here on earth and once we get to heaven?

Look up 1 Timothy 5:24,25. Put these verses into your own words. What is the “take away” principle from these two concluding verses of this section? Do these verses scare you or bring comfort? Why? Explain. What type of sin might be “obvious” and what sins “trail behind” until we get the BEMA? How is this principle equally true for our “good deeds” we do? What might we learn about God in these two verses?

**Divide your group into two groups.* Have one group look up Romans 12:7-21 and the other Matthew 19:27-30. What is the context of your passage? How might this passage apply to our BIG IDEA (God Sees Everything, Forgets Nothing and Rewards Eternally)?

**In those same two groups, look up Revelation 20:11-15 and 1 Corinthians 3:10-15*

What is the basis of each judgement?

How does each judgement end?
