Read 1 Timothy 6:3-5. What characteristics are attributed to these false teachers? According to verse 5, what was their motivation? Compare and Contrast these two views . . . The False Teachers, "Jesus is the path to Prosperity". Jesus, "Pick up your cross and follow me". Why are false teachers often popular?

"If you live a life in line with God's Word, the Law of Reaping and Sowing will guide you towards success, wealth, and prosperity. How would you respond to the counter argument (godliness does equal gain)?

Read 1 Timothy 6:9,10. What 3 words/phrases describe what the real warning is about in regards to money? How are these similar? Different?



Love of money destroys people. What might the temptation of riches be? What traps have you personally encountered in regards to money/materialism?

Read 1 Timothy 6:9,10 again. Find the 3 corresponding words/phrases that picture a particularly disastrous ending. Why would Paul paint such a picture of the total devastation of both body and soul for this church?

Digging Deeper

Read 1 Timothy 6:6-8. Wealth rarely brings contentment. Look up Phil. 4:11-13 and Hebrews 13:5... What is the "secret sauce" for finding contentment? As you have matured in Christ, has contentment become easier or harder to find? Why?



Read Jesus' words of warning in regards to riches, Luke 8:14 and Matthew 6:24 . . . How have riches "strangled" out the word in your life? Others? Jesus says you can't serve two masters. What does he exactly mean?
