

50-in-50 Celebration Update

Dear Church Family,

We are excited to share that together we reached our goal of raising \$50,000 in 50 days! Your generosity, faith, and participation in the 50-in-50 Campaign have been a powerful testimony of God's provision and the unity of our community.

God moved in and through us powerfully in this season! Each dollar, prayer, and sacrifice has laid a stronger foundation for the future of our church and its ministries.

50-in-50 was about more than just money. It was an invitation into deeper life with Jesus through three key practices — giving, praying, and fasting.

GIVE: Since we met our goal of \$50,000, funds will be allocated as follows:

- \$30,000 address budget shortfalls & rebuild savings
- \$15,000 facility improvements: Quiet room, prayer & meeting room, youth space, fresh paint, and carpet cleaning (see details on back)
- 10% (\$5,000) given to organizations serving our community: Alicia's Closet, Kairos Prison Ministry (Marion MCI Chapter), Unity Community Center | STEAM, Main Street Delaware, and TreeHouse Young Adult Transitional Living

PRAY: If 100 people prayed 10 prayers a day for 50 days, we would have prayed **50,000 prayers** together! We focused on **God's provision and His vision for DCV**, using prayer prompts and guides to unite us in prayer.

<u>FAST:</u> Our goal was **5,000 hours of fasting** as a church. Fasting took many forms — food, technology, routines — all creating space in our hearts for God to move.

This campaign wasn't just about meeting a financial goal. It was about making room for more people to encounter Jesus, find a sense of belonging among His people, and find their purpose in His mission.

Church, thank you for your generosity and faithfulness over the past 50 days. It's a joy to partner with you in the work God is doing in and through DCV.

Facility Improvement Plan

Phase 1 – Facility Refresh & Volunteer Support

Timeline: Aug - Oct | Budget: \$2,000

Facility-Wide Carpet Cleaning

- Goal: Improve cleanliness and appearance in sanctuary, lobby, hallways, family ministry wing
- Professional deep cleaning with eco-friendly solutions

Volunteer Storage Solutions

- Goal: Organize and streamline ministry supplies
- Scope & Solutions:
 - o Family Ministry: Shelving, cubbies, bins
 - o Host Team: Central storage, labeled carts, communion supplies
 - Youth: Equipment cabinets, shelving
 - o Compassion ministries: Organization, clearly labeled storage
 - o General Church: Central closets, mobile carts, volunteer storage areas
- Timeline: 2 months (can overlap with other projects)

Phase 2 – Ministry Space Additions & Aesthetic Upgrades

Timeline: September (Planning/Quotes)-Q4 2025 (Execution) | Budget: \$13,000

Quiet Room Construction

- Goal: Comfortable, sound-buffered space for parents/guardians and children
- Features: Soundproofing, seating, changing table, toys, audio feed, ventilation

Prayer Room Construction

- Goal: Dedicated space for prayer, reflection, small groups, pastoral meetings
- Features: Soundproofing, calming décor, lighting, artwork, Bibles, seating

Fresh Paint & Finish Detailing

- Goal: Brighten high-traffic areas, create a welcoming environment
- Scope: Lobby, hallways, family ministry, some sanctuary walls, youth space
- Colors: Neutral tones (public areas), vibrant accents (youth areas)

Youth Space Revitalization

Timeline: Immediate-Early October

- Goal: Vibrant, flexible space for youth ministry
- Design: Flexible seating, tech integration, activity/game zones, ample storage
