

Hello St. Mark's,

Holy smokes! The summer is flying by and August 14th will make it one year for me at St. Mark's. I am so grateful for you all! You're faithful, generous, and incredibly kind. We've had quite a bit of change in a year, and I know that's not easy, but you have met the change with grace and class. My family and I are so appreciative of your love and hospitality.

It has been a very busy summer so far with the leadership working hard on a couple of projects. Most of the energy has been going into developing our new website though, which should be up and going by the fall. We've also been working on being strategic and forward planning for the life of the church community. Ideally, we will be 6 months ahead in our planning. For instance, at July's Vestry Meeting we started talking about fall stewardship and the annual cookie walk.



Some might be wondering: why a new website? Our website was developed and maintained for the last 20 years by Kit Marceil. And while he has done an amazing job, he has told us that he is ready to pass the baton. We've hired a consultant, who specialize in helping small businesses and organizations, that will help our new website meet the needs of our community going forward. It will allow for easier access to live streaming, sermons, information, upcoming events, and donating to the church. I am super excited for the new possibilities and am so grateful for Kit's incredible dedication to keeping the information up to date. It's a huge task which he has done faithfully. Thank you so much Kit.

We now have a master calendar in the Narthex right by the staircase to the loft. This will be where building use and events are coordinated as we get busier at the church. We put it in a central location where everyone could have access to it so everyone can keep up on what's going on.

Speaking of schedules: I will be coming out with a schedule for ministry training for new and current readers, acolytes, intercessors, chalice bearers, and ushers as well as eucharistic ministers to the homebound. If you're considering joining a ministry this is a great time to sign up. You can contact Maison in the office or me if you're interested. We'll be having refreshers and training every six months to a year depending on need.

We're planning a Youth/Young Adult Mission/High Adventure trip for next summer, sometime in June or July, and we've invited Grace Episcopal from Missouri to join us. We'll be working on a Habitat for Humanity house for 2 days and then going to Boundary waters in Minnesota for 5 days for canoeing and camping. The age group is intentionally wide so that a wider group of youth and young adults are eligible. Older adults interested in being on the leadership team are always welcome. More information will be coming.

Starting in September there will be confirmation class 3 Sundays a month after church for Sept. and Oct. Bishop Lee comes in November, and we'll have confirmations, receptions, and reaffirmations. Please see me if you are interested in being confirmed Episcopalian, received into our church from another faith tradition,

or to reaffirm your faith.

I will also be continuing my parish home visits; calling a few members every week with a couple questions and an opportunity to visit you in your home if you would like.

It has been a busy summer but it will be an even busier fall. I am looking forward to taking the ride with you St. Mark's.

St. Mark's Episcopal Church Vestry Meeting Minutes June 26th, 2022

Wardens; Fred Ellis, Treasurer; David Genereaux, Visitor, and Mason Yaroch, Clerk of Vestry

Call to Order: 10:34 AM

Opened with prayer by Fr. Mike, followed by a reading from The Blessings of Brokeness by Jody

Linda made a motion to accept the minutes as presented, _____ seconded the motion; Motion Carried

Joann made a motion to move Jr. Warden's report up to before the Treasurer's Report on the Agenda, Chris
seconded the motion; Motion Carried

Jr. Warden's Report

- **1.** Want to get started on the wall preparation for the new glass window, requested permission to take wheel down and move it to where guests sign in. Permission granted by Vestry to move Bell Wheel. Linda made a motion to empower the Jr. Wardens to spend up to \$340 on the window project, motion seconded by Joann. Motion Carried.
- 2. Lawn mower blew a gasket, Jody has offered up her push mower
- 3. New faucet was installed in the Fireside Room sink.
- **4.** Gas fireplace insert for Fireside Room put on hold until next year. Guesstimate to complete the Gas Fireplace. Insert is \$200
- Fr. Mike suggests community grocery list, all agree, list will be on refrigerator.

Treasurer Report

Fred Ellis presented the Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss Statement for the month ended May 31, 2022. Questions were asked and explained or will be followed up on. Joann accepted the Treasurers Report as presented on behalf of the Vestry.

Old Business

1. Stonehouse Digital Consulting

- a. Andrea proposed consulting-only role; hourly vs. full cost upfront
- **b.** Contingency needed Maison cannot be the only one able to run whatever website end up with Chris Merrill agreed to be secondary website manager.
- **c.** Kevin made a motion to go forward with hiring Andrea for full services for no more than \$5,000. Joann seconded. Motion Carried

2. Directory Update

a. Maison has all the photos David took of congregation members, as well as the member sheets that were filled out

b. Joann & Maison will work on putting the directory together

3. Birthday party for July 10th

- a. Joann will coordinate and ask for assistance from Betsy Lampert and Gayle Elbert
- b. Maison will make a flyer

4. Choir Update

- a. Ken left meeting early but Joann said he has 5 hymns and Lizzie has been asked to record them
- **b.** It was suggested that in September the choir start singing once a month

5. Altar Guild Handbook

a. Linda has the old one & the new one which was done by Heidi Tess for Good Shepherd. Linda will be making a version specific to St. Mark's

6. Zoom Account

a. It was decided the Zoom Account get used enough to keep for another year. Joann made a motion to renew for another year at the cost of \$150.00 Linda seconded, Motion Carried.

New Business

1. New phone number

- a. Works, no longer rings only once. It rings three times and then goes to Fr. Mike's Voicemail.
- **b.** Has been changed on both facebook and the church website

2. Other

- **a.** Do we want to put our own contact information on the Diocese website verdict is Yes-Chris Merrill will take care of getting the information to the Diocesean Office..
- **b.** Linda brought up the lack of web address & Wednesday service times on the sign on our door and the outdoor sign in the parking lot.. Will ask Dave and Ken to fix the parking lot sign, Joann will fix the sign on the door.
 - c. Tech grant will be written by Jody and Chris with assistance from Heidi Tess.
 - **d.** Kit renewed the security certificate for our current website
 - e. Communal calendar will be put up to help everyone keep track of tasks and events

2. Eucharist changes

- **a.** Individual cups will be discontinued next week. We will be going back to just the using the chalice, but not drinking out of it, everyone will intinct their own hosts
- **3.** Passing of the offertory plate will begin in July.
- **4.** Fred & Joann will be donating a basketball hoop, there was a question about liability. Fr. Mike said it would be added into our Insurance Policy.

5. Youth/Young Adults Trip

- **a.** Grace Episcopal from Missouri Young Adults presented Fr. Mike a \$1,500. check in thanksgiving for their stay here. Fr. Mike has reached out to them to extend and invitation for them to come back next year to stay at St. Mark's and to work on a Habitat for Humanity house for a few days and then they and St. Mark's Young Adults (ages 18-25) go to Boundary Waters
 - **b.** Youth-driven fundraisers to help pay for it

c. Kids pay a 3rd, church budget a line item for a 3rd, parishioners would be asked for donations for a 3rd

6. Shirts & Sweatshirts

- **a.** Fr. Mike asked about the desire for golf shirts and sweatshirts with the St. Mark's logo. Both were well received, and Fr. Mike will pursue the set up of an online store for purchasing. He will also put the Tess Team Orange Cancer T-Shirts on for purchasing. One half of the proceeds will go to the cancer foundation and one half will come back to St. Mark's
- **7.** Suggests talent fair or silent talent auction for November / late fall people in the parish use their talents to raise money for the church.
- 8. Joyce DeZarn will host the August Home Eucharist

Records Project Update from David

- **a.** Liturgical Top of stairs, Musical Under front pews, Sunday School Upstairs in a file cabinet, Priest Records "are around and we will find some eventually"
 - b. The plan is to eventually get more files scanned
 - c. David would like to coordinate this project with the diocese as history records are important to them
- **d.** David requested and received Fr. Mike's blessing to check in with the Diocese without officially representing the church

The profit for the month of May was \$116.28.


