



Outreach Committee - Letters sent out May 10th. Neither Kevin nor Linda have heard back from anyone (letters were sent out but also emails)

Safe Church Link - Jody emailed out to everyone who needs it

Dementia Training - A date needs to be set for this. A % of our leadership needs to do it for us to be considered dementia friendly. We get to decide what "leadership" means. Jody will get a hold of Rob to find out how long the training is before we set anything up

Talent Fair - October. 8th – 22nd. It will go online. Carolyn knows people who have done hybrid online / in person silent auctions and she'll talk to them about how they do it. Talents only, and gift cards?? (a mentioned possibility) "Any items online won't be sold in person, any items in person won't be sold online" was suggested by Carolyn as it would be easier on everyone involved. The formation of a Talent Auction Committee happened suddenly. Chris, Carolyn, and Deb (and sometimes Fr. Mike) are the committee members

New Business

Bishop Reception - A small cake & coffee was agreed upon because it takes place so late at night. Deb will order it & pick it up (edit: Carolyn will pick it up)

Flowers for the Altar - Red and white carnations were decided upon

Altar Decorations - Wed. the 24th of May – some people have agreed to stay after the service to help change decorations

St. Mark's Obligation for Trip to Mexico - "We don't really have one" - Fr. Mike. Our cost is just paying for a supply priest. Emily will be reimbursing.

Advertising Plant & Bake Sale – Flyers will be put up at 3 laundromats, Piggly Wiggly, Rechek's, the library, and the legion. Electronic advertising at Piggly Wiggly and Rechek's was discussed, as well as the radio and

newspaper. Maison will be putting it on facebook and our website.

Joyful Noise Update - Our part in the planning is done. Free will donation will cover Mitch, other churches will also cover Mitch. Fr. Mike has met with Rechek's, Piggly Wiggly, and Walmart regarding food donations (rechecks needs 30 days before the event, which none of us knew)

- **a.** If it rains REALLY BAD it'll be moved to St. Mark's. We were originally talking about moving it to St. Katharine's but the people helping with this event aren't priests, they're younger leaders, so they do not have access to the church


