

gave the church a generous gift for letting them stay. They loved attending the Celebration of New Ministry and on Thursday I had a mass for them.



St. Mark's Episcopal Church Vestry Meeting Minutes May 15, 2022

- **1. Call to Order @ 10:38 am. Those in attendance were:** Joann Ellis, Kevin Luebke, Christine Merrill, Linda Zamzow, Jody Langfeldt, Senior Warden, Fred Ellis, Treasurer, and Fr. Mike Tess. Also in attendance were Jim Merrill, Zoom Meeting Coordinator and Joyce DeZarn, Clerk. Members absent were Erin Weirough, and Jr. Wardens Dave Drexler and Ken Peters.
- **2. Opening Prayer/Devotion** Fr. Mike offered the Noon Day Prayer as our opening devotion.
- **3.** Minutes of the April Vestry meeting were approved as presented by a motion made by Linda Zamzow and second by Christine Merrill.

4. Treasurer's Report

- **a**. Balance Sheet was reviewed. Our investments Line Item #770 lost money this last quarter. Linda Zamzow suggested that we move the money of \$44.00 from Line Item #250.9 Lydia in Uganda to Line Item #262 Relief & Development. All were in agreement.
- **b. Profit & Loss Sheet -** It was noted we are in need of more cameras to be able to better livestream our services. The cost is approximately \$500.00 each and would like to be able to add 3 to 4 additional cameras. There is a balance of \$304.59 in Line Item #250.5 Sound System Money Market. There needs to be some conversation with the congregation about raising funds for the additional technical costs and about keeping their pledges current as they are currently about \$8,500 in arrears. We will also need to increase the budgeted amount for Fr. Mike's Travel Expense as that will increase with the .75-time Rector. After a review and discussion, the Treasurers Report was accepted as presented.
- c. Fr. Mike's covenant At the Annual Meeting we presented the budget to show Fr. Mike becoming .75-time Rector in June. The new covenant has been updated, sent to the Diocese along with our Financial Information. On Fr. Mike, Jody Langfeldt and Fred and Joann Ellis had a Zoom Meeting with the Diocesan Financial Controller, Caroline Senn and Canon for Ministries, The Rev. Scott Leannah. Fr. Mike has insurance through the Sun Prairie School District until 8/31/22 and Heidi is under UW Health. After discussion, it was decided the Health Insurance will be put into a HSA (Health Savings Account). HSA's can be used to pay premiums and co-payments. HSA's also roll over at the end of the year. An FSA (Family Savings Account) will also be set up but those funds need to be spent every year. It was also noted travel expenses will increase to \$2000.00 for the year. We were given the go ahead to have Fr. Mike begin his .75-time hours as of June 1, 2022. Three quarters time will find Fr. Mike presiding over worship service every Sunday (1 service), he will have a week night service (currently Wednesday evening) and he will have two afternoons for conducting St. Mark's business. Fr. Mike has also applied for a Chaplain position.
- **d. Annual Appeal (Formerly the Bishop's Purse) Total** The total was \$125 and the Vestry had pledged to match up to \$200. So, we will be able to send \$250.00 to the Bishop's Annual Appeal. The matching funds will be taken from Account #259.

- **a. Installation Service** June 15th with a reception outside There will be a Celebration of New Ministry service on June 15th. Bishop Jeff Lee will be officiating the service and we will have a reception afterwards.
 - **b. Concert** Mitch McVickers will be here on Tuesday, October 11th.
 - **c. Directory Update** David Genereaux is working on getting current pictures of all members.
 - d. Keep Laura from Restore and projects on the agenda
- **e. Stained Glass** Ken and Dave are working on the large stained glass window installation, hoping to have that project completed by the end of June.

 - g. Altar Guild Booklet Tabled
- **h. Octogenarian Birthday** Set date (Dave Genereaux, Kit Marceil, Millie Garside, Fr. Mike's Mom It was decided to rename it to the Celebrations of the Decades. The date was set for June 5 to kick off the return of Coffee Hours.

7. New Business

a. Rector's Report

- i. Window for Paul Lampert Betsy wants to have a stained-glass window installed in memory of Paul. The window between the closet and the Columbarium/Chapel is where it will be placed.
- **ii. Coffee Hour** We will return to having coffee hours on June 5th with the Decades Birthday Celebration. It was requested we have Maison Yaroch make an announcement.
- **iii. Website Meeting** Stone House Digital Consulting Kit Marceil has resigned effective June 30, 2022 as our Webmaster. Jody Langfeldt and Fr. Mike have met with Andrea from Stone House Digital Consulting.
 - iv. Vestry Retreat Minutes from the Retreat were distributed prior to this meeting.
 - v. Information Only Item Episcopal Youth from Missouri will be using our building June 13-18.
 - vi. Outdoor Creche Fr. Mike is working on getting pieces that are 48" tall.

b. Sr. Warden's Report

- **vii. Website committee** There will be a meeting on May 18, 2022 at 3:45 pm. for those interested to meet with Andrea and see her presentation for St. Mark's. Kevin Luebke currently works on the Beaver Dam Orchestra Website. The plan is to have Andrea to look at St. Mark's current website in May and give us a cost estimate, set up the new website in June, and have the new website up and running in July.
- **i. Consolidation of Committees** see handout distributed prior to today's meeting. Let Jody Langfeldt know which committee(s) you would like to be a part of.

c. Jr. Warden's Report

i. Update hot water in women's bathroom – Tabled neither Jr. Wardens were available for the meeting

ii. Garbage Update – Fred Ellis reported that Ken had called the City Garbage company and their costs were quite high. We will continue to have members take the garbage out weekly.

8. Other New Business

- a. Cleaning schedule Linda Zamzow will work on this as to what needs to done and how often.

- **12. Closing prayer –** Fr. Mike led us with the closing prayer
- 13. Adjourn Joann Ellis moved to adjourn the meeting at 12:25 pm


