# Venture Camp Cell Phone Policy

We understand that cell phones are a big part of everyday life, but at camp, we want to create an environment where students can be fully present, build relationships, and grow in their faith without unnecessary distractions.

# Lights Out = Phones In

All phones must be turned in to a Venture leader at lights out each night. Phones will be returned in the morning when we wake up.

# During the Day

Students may use their phones during **free time**, but we ask that social media use be limited to stay focused on the camp experience.

#### Phones are **NOT allowed** during:

- Worship services
- Small/church group time
- Recreation activities

#### Serient Communication

Parents are welcome to **contact their student during daytime free time** if needed. We recommend texting or calling during lunch or free time hours (see schedule above). Parents are always welcome to contact Brad to relay anything to their students as well.

#### O Distractions & Misuse

If a phone becomes a distraction or is used inappropriately, it may be held by a leader for the remainder of the day or longer, depending on the situation.

### Venture Camp Modest Clothing Policy

At Venture, we want every student to feel comfortable, confident, and free from distractions as we grow in faith and community. To help ensure this, we ask all campers to follow these modesty guidelines when packing and dressing for camp:

#### Tops:

- No low-cut shirts or shirts that expose cleavage.
- No crop tops or tops that expose the midriff.
- No thin straps (spaghetti straps); straps should be at least 2 inches wide.
- Sleeveless tops are allowed as long as they are modest (no large armholes or low-cut sides).

#### **Bottoms:**

- Shorts should be longer than the hem of your shirt (even when arms are raised).
- Leggings may be worn with a longer top that provides full coverage.

#### Swimwear:

- Girls must wear a one-piece swimsuit or a full-coverage tankini.
- Boys should wear swim trunks and a t-shirt for water activities.

#### Pajamas:

 Pajamas should be modest and appropriate for shared sleeping spaces. (Example: pajama pants and a t-shirt.)

#### **General Guidelines:**

- Clothing should not have offensive language, graphics, or promote alcohol/drugs.
- If a Venture leader deems an outfit inappropriate, campers will be asked to change.

Thank you for respecting these expectations and helping us create a positive, distraction-free camp environment!

Parents may be contacted if a student refuses to abide by any and all policies and guidelines. In certain cases parents may be asked to come pick up their student at their own expense.

#### **Bus Seating & Small Groups Policy**

# Bus Seating:

To maintain a respectful and safe environment during travel:

- Girls will sit with girls, and boys will sit with boys on the bus.
- Adult leaders will be seated throughout the bus to help supervise and support students.

#### Small Groups:

Small group time is one of the most important parts of our camp experience. To make discussions more personal and age-appropriate:

- Students will be divided into Junior High and High School groups.
- Each group will be separated by gender JH Girls, JH Boys, HS Girls, HS Boys

Our goal is to create a space where every student feels comfortable, heard, and encouraged in their faith journey!

# First Aid

- We carry two medical backpacks with OTC meds & basic supplies.
- A venture leader will always call parents before administering any medication that is not listed on the medical form.
- Students may NOT carry medications. All meds must be listed on the medical form and turned in prior to camp

# **∮** Energy Drink Policy

While we leave the final decision to **parental discretion**, please note the following:

Venture will **not** provide or purchase energy drinks for students at any time. Energy drinks are **not** allowed on the bus during travel to and from camp.

We encourage students to stay hydrated with **water and sports drinks** to support their health and energy throughout the week.

# Sleeping & Meals Policy

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Final room details will be shared closer to camp, but students will stay in dorm-style housing, with 2–4 students per room. Dorms may include suite-style, private, or community bathrooms, depending on the assigned building.

- Students will be placed in rooms by age and gender.
- Adult leaders will stay in separate rooms nearby for supervision and support.
- Students must stay in their own assigned beds each night.
- Respectful behavior and quiet hours will be expected to ensure rest for all.

#### Meals

Campers will eat in a spacious, on-campus cafeteria

- Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are provided daily.
- A variety of meal options are available, including kid-friendly and allergyconscious choices.
- Campers are expected to eat during designated mealtimes and clean up after themselves.
