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## Packing List — Bring Everything Listed

### Spiritual Supplies

- Bible (we can provide if needed)
- Journal/notepad & pen
- Small bag for Bible supplies (optional)

### Clothing

- Modest clothing (see Venture guidelines below) — enough for 2 outfits per day
- 1 pair of pants & a sweatshirt
- Pajamas (t-shirt and sleep pants)
- Socks and tennis shoes
- Old tennis shoes for recreation/water day
- 3 sets of dark-colored clothes for recreation
- House color items (Red or Blue)

### Bedding & Hygiene

- Pillow & blanket or sleeping bag
- Full-size sheet
- **Alarm clock** (*phones will be turned in*)
- 2 towels
- Toiletries (shampoo, deodorant, toothbrush, etc.)
- Sunscreen & bug spray
- Chapstick
- Hand soap (*not provided in dorms*)

- Shower shoes

## **Everything Else**

- Refillable water bottle (**REQUIRED**)
- Spending money and/or Camp Bucks
- Notes/snacks from home ("Love from Home")
- Chargers & optional power strip
- Small personal fan
- Students may bring **3 bags total** (trash bags are **not** preferred)
- A heart ready to grow, learn, serve, and have fun!

**Please label all belongings.**

Luggage breakdown

1. **Bus Bag:** For the bus ride — snacks, Bible, journal, etc.
2. **Clothing Bag:** For clothing and recreation outfits
3. **Bedding Bag:** For pillow, blanket/sleeping bag, and sheets

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## **Policies & Expectations**

### **Venture Camp Cell Phone Policy**

We want students to be fully present, build relationships, and grow in faith without distractions.

#### **Lights Out = Phones In**

- Phones must be turned in to a Venture leader each night.
- Returned each morning.

#### **During the Day:**

Phones may be used during free time only.

Not allowed during:

- Worship services
- Small/church group time

- Recreation activities

**Parent Communication:**

Parents may contact students during free time or lunch.

Parents may also contact Brad to relay messages.

**Misuse:**

If a phone becomes a distraction or is used inappropriately, it will be held by a leader for the remainder of the day or longer.

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 **Venture Camp Modest Clothing Policy**

To help every student feel comfortable and confident, please follow these guidelines:

**Tops:**

- No low-cut or midriff-exposing shirts.
- No thin straps (minimum 2" width).
- Sleeveless tops allowed if modest (no large armholes).

**Bottoms:**

- Shorts should be longer than the hem of your shirt (even when arms are raised).
- Leggings are allowed only with longer tops that provide full coverage.

**Pajamas:**

- Modest and appropriate for shared spaces (e.g., pajama pants and t-shirt).

**General:**

- No clothing with offensive language, graphics, or alcohol/drug references.
- Students will be asked to change if clothing is deemed inappropriate.

Parents may be contacted if students refuse to comply. In certain cases, parents may be asked to pick up their student at their own expense.

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## **Bus Seating & Small Groups Policy**

### **Bus Seating:**

- Girls sit with girls; boys sit with boys.
- Adult leaders will be seated throughout the bus for supervision.

### **Small Groups:**

- Divided by **age and gender**:
    - JH Girls, JH Boys, HS Girls, HS Boys
  - Helps ensure a personal, safe, and encouraging environment.
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## **First Aid**

- Two medical backpacks with OTC meds and basic supplies are available.
  - A Venture leader will call parents before administering any medication not listed on the medical form.
  - Students may NOT carry medications — ALL must be turned in prior to camp.
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## **Energy Drink Policy**

- Venture will not provide or purchase energy drinks.
  - Energy drinks are **not allowed** on the bus.
  - If your student does purchase one, parents, please talk with your child about only drinking one a day.
  - Students are encouraged to drink water and sports drinks instead.
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## **Sleeping & Meals Policy**

### **Sleeping Arrangements:**

- Dorm-style housing (2–4 students per room).
- Grouped by age and gender.
- Adult leaders in nearby rooms for supervision.
- Students must stay in assigned rooms and beds.
- We personally treat each room for bed bugs.

### **Meals:**

- All meals are served in the on-campus cafeteria.
  - Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are provided daily.
  - Kid-friendly and allergy-conscious options available.
  - Students are expected to eat at designated times and clean up after themselves.
  - Please notify us ahead of time about any allergies or dietary restrictions.
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### **Spending Money**

There are several locations where students can spend money, such as the **Generate Camp store, Chick-fil-A, Starbucks, and the Student Center**, which offers snacks, sodas, and energy drinks.

Please talk with your child about where they may want to spend their money.

**Important:** Camp Bucks can ONLY be used on Generate merchandise.

Please also send enough money for **lunch on the first day of camp**, as we will stop on the way there.

It is best to send **Apple Pay, cash, or a debit/credit card** for purchases.

**MasterCard and Visa gift cards did not work well in the past and are not recommended.**
