2025 ELCA Churchwide Assembly: The ELCA Churchwide Assembly, the primary decision-making body of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America, convened place July 28 - August 2 in Phoenix, AZ under the theme "For the Life of the World." As vice-president of the North/West Lower MI Synod (one of 65 ELCA synods), Sandy Schlesinger attended as a voting member along with Bishop Craig Satterlee, Bishop-Elect Julie Schneider-Thomas and seven

other lay and rostered voting members from across our synod. In addition to meaningful worship each day, key business included election of Yehiel Curry, bishop of the Metropolitan Chicago Synod as the next presiding bishop of the ELCA; election of Pr. Lucille "CeCee" Mills, assistant to the bishop in the North Carolina Synod as secretary of the ELCA; approval of a new social statement titled "Faith & Civic Life: Seeking the Well-Being of All"; approval of editorial changes to the 2009 social statement titled "Human Sexuality: Gift & Trust" along with consideration of proposed budgets, constitutional changes and multiple memorials and resolutions covering a wide variety of topics and initiatives.
