#### SUMMER BIBLE STUDY: Welcome and LGBTQIA+ Identities (Gathering Room)

Christians are called to share the love of Jesus with all the world. As part of an exploration of how Trinity understands welcome within our congregation, Vicar Tim will lead a summer Bible study on LGBTQIA+ identities. Jesus' vision of community is expansive, so even in times when our larger society feels anxious, we Christians are called to pause, to learn, and to listen.

While focused in many ways on LGBTQIA+ identities, this Bible study also will examine questions of how to translate and interpret scripture across history. It will be a chance to put into practice some of the Lutheran approaches to reading the Bible that we learned about last fall as part of our Ignite education program. It also will be an opportunity to wrestle faithfully with the nuances and ambiguities of language.

The Bible study will begin on Wednesday, June 25th at 6 PM, with a repeat of each session on the following Sunday night. The sessions run for 6 weeks, but there will be a break on July 16th and 20th while Vicar Tim visits family out of state. The last Wednesday will be August 6th and the last Sunday, August 10th.

Please note, there will be no meal in the hour beforehand since there is no Ignite program through the summer.

• Week 4—"Stories of Christian Acceptance"—Wednesday, July 23rd and Sunday, July 27th Key scripture passages: Deuteronomy 22.1-12 & 23.1-8; Isaiah 56; Matthew 19.1-12; Acts 8.26-40.

Week 5—"What about the Prohibitions?"—Wednesday, July 30th and Sunday, August 3rd

Key scripture passages: Leviticus 18, 20, & 25; Romans 1; 1 Corinthians 5-6; 1 Timothy 1.
