CHURCH COUNCIL MINUTES Thursday, October 19, 2023

The meeting was called to order by President Jason Kurtz at 5:30 p.m.

- Members present: Jason Kurtz, Mark Venturin, Arlene Burm, Jana Clevenger, Jim Look, Trudy Archer, Lynn Larson (by phone), Doug Eckmann, Pastor Stein
- Opening devotion and prayer on Ps. 121 by Pastor Stein
- A motion was made by Jana and seconded by Mark to approve the meeting agenda. Motion passed.
- A motion was made by Jana and seconded by Jim to approve the Sept. 21, 2023 minutes. Motion passed
- A motion was made by Mark and seconded by Lynn to approve the Sept. 30, 2023 treasurer's report. Motion passed.

Committee Reports:

- Mutual Ministry: Jason and Mark met with Trudy and Jim Kreger for discussion on their jobs.
- Property/Maintenance: Mark reported that the lawn service continues to do a good job.
- Social Ministry: WELCA will probably start meeting in November. Totes of Grace will start soon.

Old Business:

Electrical Update: All electrical equipment is in and permit was submitted but returned. Electrician will resubmit information for permit.

Update on Task Force: Chapel-by-the-Sea is ready to move forward and will discuss cost sharing with their session. Tent (20x40) is set up in the parking lot and is ready to use.

Architect follow-up discussion: Mark met with the architect and we are ready to go ahead with drawing up plans for the bathrooms, ramps, etc.

New Business:

Addition of new council member: A motion was made by Jason and seconded by Jim to elect Doug Eckmann to the Council to fill in the vacancy left by Rhona Diamond. Motion passed. The congregation will vote on his election at the December meeting.

Lau Hall Demolition: After much soul searching and discussion it was decided that Lau Hall would have to come down. Trying to fix it would put us over the 50% rule from FEMA. It would not be insurable and would still be vulnerable to future storm surges. Doug checked with PAW Demolition to get an estimate which was \$34,800. A motion was made by Arlene and seconded by Jana to hire PAW Demolition. Motion carried.

Sunday Worship: It was decided to begin worship on the Beach on Sunday, November 5th, 2023 at 9:00 A.M. We will need to advertise via Beach Radio, the Observer, signs, and e-mails sent out to St. Peter and

- Chapel-By-The-Sea members. Cider and doughnuts will be provided and possibly special music.
- We will need to get Comcast to reinstall our internet equipment for live-streaming or do video taping.
- Jason will contact Connie from the Florida/Bahama synod to find out about supply pastors. The task force will also try to come up with a list of lay leaders and possible other supply pastors for the Sunday services.
- Trudy has a tentative service folder ready to use that combines elements from the Lutheran and Presbyterian services.
- Pastor Stein's contract may need to be altered depending on what we learn from the synod as he is not available to us for Sunday worship services.
- A motion was made by Arlene and seconded by Jana to submit an additional check for \$500.00 to Peace Lutheran Church in appreciation for their willingness to share their facilities with us this past year. Motion passed.
- A tentative proposed budget formulated by Trudy and Beth Rediker was discussed. We will take another look at it in November when we have more figures available.
- A motion was made by Jim and seconded by Mark to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed. Meeting adjourned at 7:23 p.m. with the Lord's Prayer.

Addendum: By e-mail a motion was made by Jason and seconded by Doug to approve an additional amount of \$14,599 to remove the end wall and breezeway canopy of Lau Hall and an additional amount of \$1731 to remove the pilings and piece of loose concrete. This would bring the total removal cost to \$51,201 instead of the \$34,871 that was initially approved. The motion passed 5-2.
