

The meeting was called to order by President Jason Kurtz at 5:26 p.m.

Opening prayer by Pastor Wigdahl followed by member introductions.

A motion was made by Mark and seconded by Jim to approve the meeting agenda.

A motion was made by Doug and seconded by Mark to approve the April 25, 2025 secretary's report. Motion passed.

A motion was made by Arlene and seconded by Mark to approve the April 30, 2025 treasurer's report. Motion passed.

Property Report: Mark reported on the palm tree removal and purchase of new trees. Mark made a motion to remove the two palms at the front of the sanctuary and purchase 2 new ones for \$2,297.50 which includes Christmas palms, delivery and installation. Doug seconded the motion. Motion passed.

Repairs Update: there are still a few plumbing issues being dealt with. The new elevator will be installed on May 27, 2025. There will be additional railings installed on the wider staircases.


Sign Update: One more signature is needed to get the permit to go ahead with the new sign.

Organist Update: A candidate was interviewed at the church by Arlene, Trudy, and 3 choir members. It was decided her organ skills are not sufficient to lead congregational singing. Arlene will continue as organist for now.

Building Usage: we discussed how to proceed with a policy for our building usage for weddings, meetings by outside groups, etc. Trudy and Rexann will try to put together a plan for how to go forward.

Trudy handed out our hurricane protocol for 2022 which needs updating and assignment of duties to people willing to help out in anticipation of a hurricane. We will look over what has been done and try to work out a plan for our next meeting.
