WHAT WE'LL Learn

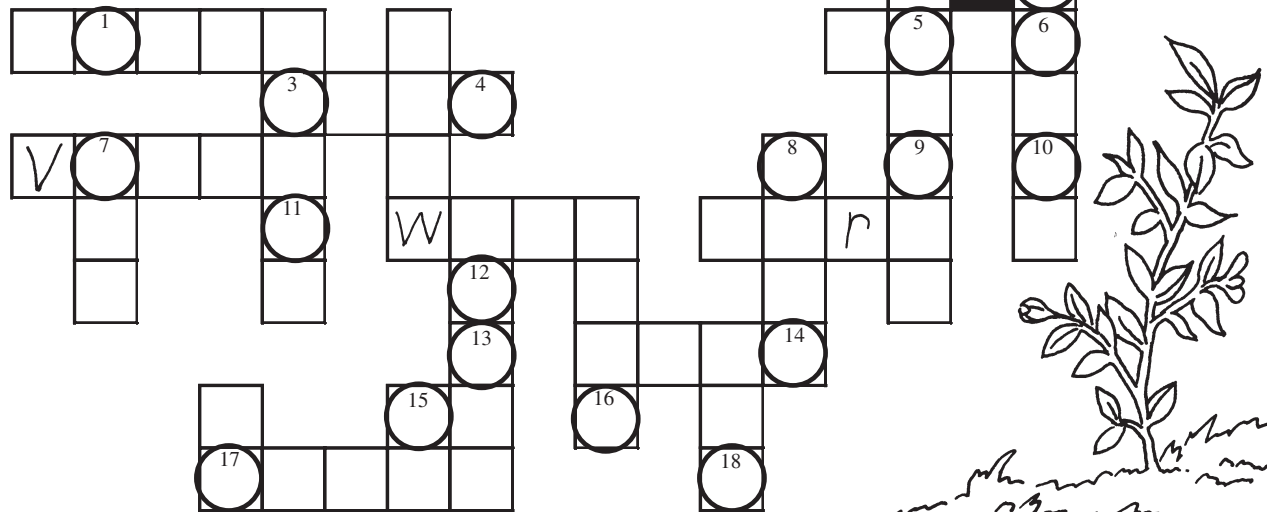
This month your child will be studying the two sacraments of the Christian church—the Lord's Supper (or Communion) and baptism. Sacraments as defined by the Heidelberg Catechism "are visible, holy signs and seals . . . instituted by God so that by our use of them He might make us understand more clearly the promise of the gospel, and seal that promise" (Q.66). Notice the words: signs and seals. The challenge this month is to help our children "see" these signs God has given to the Church as evidence of the covenant He has made with His people and has kept through Jesus Christ.

As your children learn about the Lord's Supper and baptism, help them make connections between how God's promises to His people are illustrated in the Church. Remind them about the Passover from the Old Testament and Jesus's last supper from the New Testament as they observe communion in worship service. Perhaps read to them from *The Good Shepherd's Pasture* and talk with them about their own baptism or help them remember a recent baptism in your congregation.

Remember as you review these lessons with your child that the Word leads us to Christ, and the sacraments are God's visual aids. They visibly "confirm our entire salvation rests on Christ's one sacrifice for us on the cross" (Heidelberg Catechism Q. 67).
