Each Christmas season, our church gathers around a beautiful tradition: the Christmas Offering. Year after year, you, our New Life family, give sacrificially so that every single dollar can go directly to those in need. No overhead. No detours. Just compassion turned into action.

This year, we have the privilege of directing our Christmas Offering toward two extraordinary Kingdom endeavors—one that rescues precious young girls from unthinkable darkness, and another that helps build places of hope and transformation for vulnerable children and families across the world.



1. Project Rescue — Building a New Safe House for Girls Rescued from Sexual Slavery

Across India, young girls, some as young as six or seven, are trapped in the horrors of sexual trafficking. Through Project Rescue, countless children are being pulled out of bondage and given not only safety, but healing, dignity, purpose, and the hope of new life in Christ.

One of those children was Bahula.



A Story of Courage and God's Redeeming Love

Bahula was only eight years old when she was found in the red-light district, small, frail, and fighting HIV, an inherited consequence of her mother's life in forced sexual slavery. Her mother, longing for a better future for her daughter and realizing that soon her little girl would be forced into the hands of her abusers, she made the heart-wrenching decision to release her into the care of Project Rescue. It was an act of courage and love, a mother's final attempt to save her child from the torture she herself had endured.

When Bahula arrived at the safe home, the scars of her past ran deep. She had never stepped into a classroom. She could not read. She could not count. Even holding a pencil was difficult.

But she would not give up.

Her teachers celebrated her smallest victories, every letter learned, every new number written. When her first exam came, all the other students finished early. But Bahula sat at her desk for two and a half hours, refusing to quit. When the results were tallied, her teacher wept with joy: she had scored 80%.



Years passed, and with each new challenge, Bahula rose. She graduated from school, continued her studies, and eventually earned a bachelor's degree in education. Today, she walks into a classroom not as a frightened child, but as a teacher, full of hope, full of purpose, full of grace. God is not finished writing her story.

Project Rescue currently have 4

locations that are in desparate need of a new Home Of Hope. Through these homes hundreds of young girls like Bahula will be rescued and given the opportunity of a new life and a bright future.

This Christmas, New Life has the privilege of helping make this vision a reality.

Your offering will help establish a new Home Of Hope, a place where these rescued girls will receive medical care, trauma counseling, education, voca-



tional training, and most importantly, the transforming message of Jesus Christ, who alone can give them a new life and a future free from bondage.



2. Builders International — Creating Places of Hope, Safety, and Christian Education Across the Globe

The second project we are supporting this Christmas is Builders International, a ministry within our fellowship that puts hammers, blueprints, and willing hearts to work building facilities that transform communities. Their mission is in their name: they build; churches, schools, medical centers, orphanages, missionary facilities, and community centers around the world. Wherever the Kingdom is expanding, Builders International helps create the physical spaces that allow ministry to flourish.



This year, our offering will support not only a global construction project but also one that is touching the lives of vulnerable children in Chile in a profound way.

Santiago Children's Ministry Center — A Refuge for At-Risk Children

Countless children wander the treacherous streets of Santiago day and night, alone, vulnerable, and searching for safety. The Santiago Children's Ministry Center exists to meet these children in their need, offering them a place of refuge, hope, and Christian education.

What began as a ministry to children on the streets has grown into a thriving church ministering to entire families. The next step in this mission is the construction of a new Christian school, that will dramatically expand their reach.

The impact is life-changing:

- More children will gain access to hope as they seek refuge from prostitution, poverty, and homelessness.
- At-risk children in Chile, rescued from the dark streets, will be raised to become the future Christian leaders of Santiago.



• The ministry will finally be able to offer a private Christian education as an alternative to the hyper-secularized and atheistic government schools.

This is transformation at its foundation. Quite literally, as we partner with Builders International, we are helping build the walls within which young lives will be protected, discipled, and empowered.
