# **Mortgage Milestone**

With great excitement, the Board of Trustees wishes to share a recently achieved mortgage milestone. As of the end of March, the outstanding principal on our mortgage has dropped below \$300,000. Our remaining balance is \$294,795.33! With a monthly payment of \$6646, our anticipated payoff date is February of 2029. However, to shorten our payoff period, we have committed to paying an additional \$348 each month which goes directly to the principal. Often we are able to make a larger additional payment. If we continue to do so, we could be making our final mortgage payment in the fall of 2028! Thank you for your ongoing generosity to both the general fund and in paying down the mortgage. God is good – All the time! All the time - God is Good!

# Glimpses from the Past – From the Archives Committee

With May, our thoughts turn to summer programming and Luther Park Bible Camp. The "Herald of Hope" newsletter from May 1951 featured the following article:



BIBLE CAMP DAYS WITH CHRIST. Luther Park, Chetek, Wis. Senior camp – June 17-23 (for those confirmed before Jan. 1, 1951) Junior Camp – June 24-30 (for those confirmed this spring or to be confirmed next fall). A fine faculty has been secured. Pastor Axel Blom of Strum will speak at Junior Camp and Pastor Art Wigdahl will speak at Senior camp. Each camp will have a missionary. Senior – Rev. Joe Walla, missionary to South America and Junior camp – Rev. E.H. Dahle, missionary to Alaska. Register with any of the local pastors, but register as from Hope. Cost of camp - \$1.50 registration and \$7.00 upon arrival in camp. No other camp will offer you a week for so little money. No other camp can give you so much for eternity. Plan to attend.

**Hope Phone App** – Hope has a free phone app which will give you access to Subsplash where you can access information. From here you can click on the "Give" tab.

**Text Your Gift** – Text the message "give2hope" to the phone number 206-859-9409. Follow the steps to set up an account and you're on your way.

**Simple Giving** – You can set up an automatic, pre-authorized withdrawal from your bank account. Forms are available in the church office and also on the church website.
