Day 1 – Departure

Flights from the USA to Tel Aviv.

Day 2 – Arrival in Israel | Caesarea | Mt. Carmel | Galilee

Upon arrival at Ben Gurion Airport, our representatives will greet you, assist with your luggage, and escort you to your guide. Guests receive a welcome gift and a bottle of water.

Drive to Caesarea Maritima to explore the ancient port city and aqueducts, then continue to Mount Carmel for panoramic views of the Jezreel Valley. Enjoy a fellowship lunch at a Druze family restaurant (our treat), then travel to the Galilee, Check in at the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 3 – Northern Galilee | Caesarea Philippi | Magdala | Tiberias

After breakfast, visit Caesarea Philippi (Matthew 16:18) and the waterfalls, one of the sources of the Jordan River. Explore Chorazin and Bethsaida, towns under Jesus' "woes" and the home of Peter and other disciples. At Magdala, celebrate Communion on the ancient road Jesus walked.

See Eramos Cave and visit Kibbutz Ginosar to view the ancient boat. Drive east to Kursi, where Jesus healed the man with demons, and see the ruins of Herod's palace in Tiberias. Return to the hotel for dinner, then enjoy an evening walk along the promenade to take in the local atmosphere and Tiberias ruins.

Day 4 – Galilee | Capernaum | Jordan River

After breakfast, visit the Mount of Beatitudes for worship and reflection. Continue to Tabgha, the multiplication site, and Peter's Primacy, where we'll hold a Vow Renewal on the shore of the Galilee.

Explore Capernaum, including the synagogue and Greek Orthodox Monastery. Enjoy a St. Peter's Fish lunch(included) and a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee, pausing in the middle of the lake for worship and quiet reflection.

Conclude at the Jordan River Baptismal Site for a renewal of baptism. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 5 – Nazareth | Mt. Tabor | Megiddo | Jerusalem

After breakfast, check out and visit Nazareth Village, a first-century recreation of life in Jesus' time, followed by the Annunciation Church. Continue to Mount Precipice and Mount Tabor (site of the Transfiguration), then pass by Nain, the widow's village, stopping to see the village and reflect on the event.

Explore Megiddo (Revelation 16:16) and Beth Shean, an ancient Greco-Roman city. Drive to Jerusalem, view the Holy City from Mount Scopus, and check in to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 6 – Bethlehem | Herodion | Shepherd's Field

After breakfast, visit Herodion Fortress, then the Church of the Nativity and its hidden caves, celebrating with Christmas hymns together.

Enjoy lunch (traditional dish included), then visit Shepherd's Field to share Luke 2 and reflect on the stories of David and Ruth. Stop at a local Christian center to see olive wood artisans, where each pastor will receive a Shepherd's carving as a gift of honor.

Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 7 – Jerusalem | Emmaus | Valley of Elah

After breakfast, Visit the Western Wall, Teaching Steps, St. Anne's Church, Bethesda Pools, and the Essenes Gate. Continue to the Israel Museum to see the model of Jerusalem in Jesus' time and the Shrine of the Book.

Travel to Ein Karem, the village of John the Baptist's birth, then drive to Emmaus and the Valley of Elah, where David defeated Goliath. Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 8 – Masada | Ein Gedi | Qumran | Jericho | Dead Sea

After breakfast, travel south to Masada, Ein Gedi, Qumran, and Jericho. Enjoy lunch in Jericho (traditional dish included).

At Masada, reflect on steadfast faith; at Ein Gedi, recall David and Saul by the caves. Visit Qumran, where the Dead Sea Scrolls were found, and Jericho to see the Mount of Temptation and the Old Sycamore Tree. Stop at the Baptismal Site, where the Jordan River meets the Dead Sea.

Return to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 9 – Old Jerusalem / Garden Tomb

After breakfast, Walk the Via Dolorosa (Way of the Cross) and visit the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. See the Broad Wall and Cardo, then visit the Upper Room and Caiaphas' Prison.

Continue to the Mount of Olives, Palm Sunday Path, and Garden of Gethsemane, and conclude at the Garden Tomb, where we'll celebrate Communion to close the pilgrimage.

Dinner and overnight.

Day 10 – Until We Meet Again

After breakfast, transfer to the airport for your return flight. If departing in the evening, enjoy free time, a later check-out and a farewell dinner (included) before transfer.

Time permitting, there may be an optional visit to Jaffa and Tel Aviv earlier in the day.

Extensions to Jordan and Egypt are available upon request.
