**Reverence for God isn’t a fear that drives us away from God,
but an awe that draws us to Him.**

How you view God determines how you live.

Low View of God

- **Treat God's Word casually.**
- **Ignore conviction and rationalize sin.**
- **Know what God says, but do what you want.**

High View of God

- **Take God's Word seriously.**
- **Repent of your sins quickly.**
- **Obey God with reverence no matter the cost.**

“... I came into your house. You did not give me any water for my feet, but she wet my feet with her tears and wiped them with her hair. ⁴⁵You did not give me a kiss, but this woman, from the time I entered, has not stopped kissing my feet. ⁴⁶You did not put oil on my head, but she has poured perfume on my feet.” Luke 7:44-46 NIV
