1. HEAR GOD'S VOICE CLEARLY

So God said to Noah, "I am going to put an end to all people, for the earth is filled with violence because of them. I am surely going to destroy both them and the earth. 14 So make yourself an ark of cypress wood; make rooms in it and coat it with pitch inside and out. Genesis 6:13-14 NIV

My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me." John 10:27

2. OBEY GOD'S INSTRUCTIONS FULLY

22 Noah did everything just as God commanded him. Genesis 6:22 NIV

Partial obedience is still disobedience

So make yourself an ark of cypress wood; make rooms in it and coat it with pitch inside and out. 15 This is how you are to build it: Genesis 6:14-15 NIV

3. TRUSTING GOD'S TIMING PATIENTLY

But God remembered Noah and all the wild animals and the livestock that were with him in the ark, and He sent a wind over the earth, and the waters receded." Genesis 8:1 NIV

By the first day of the first month of Noah's six hundred and first year, the water had dried up from the earth. Noah then removed the covering from the ark and saw that the surface of the ground was dry. Genesis 8:13 NIV

4. SALVATION COMES BY GOD'S DESIGN

So make yourself an ark of cypress wood; make rooms in it and coat it with pitch inside and out." Genesis 6:14

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me John 14:6 ESV

I am the door. If anyone enters by me, he will be saved and will go in and out and find pasture. John 10:9 ESV

The Hebrew word for pitch is "kopher," which comes from the same root as "kippur," meaning atonement (as in Yom Kippur, the Day of Atonement).
