- 1. God's Sovereign Will: God's unstoppable, unchangeable plan that directs all things toward His purpose

2. God's Moral Will: timeless truths revealed in His Word for how we live

3. God's Permissive Will: the freedom God gives us to make choices, even when they're not perfect
