1. We over-spiritualize God's will.

Then some of the Pharisees and teachers of the law said to [Jesus], "Teacher, we want to see a sign from you." ³⁹He answered, "A wicked and adulterous generation asks for a sign! ..." Matthew 12:38-39 NIV

If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you. James 1:5 NIV

2. We overanalyze it.

And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him. Hebrews 11:6 NIV

Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; ⁶in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight. Proverbs 3:5-6 NIV

yada: to know deeply, relationally, and experientially

3. We assume that hard means wrong.
