What will I be doing when Jesus returns—

As it was in the days of Noah, so it will be at the coming of the Son of Man. 38 For in the days before the flood, people were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, up to the day Noah entered the ark; 39 and they knew nothing about what would happen until the flood came and took them all away. That is how it will be at the coming of the Son of Man.

Matthew 24:37-39 NIV

In other words — His return will interrupt the routine.

4 things the Bible clearly says we should be doing

1. Loving God Wholeheartedly

Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. Matthew 22:37

Wholehearted love doesn't mean you never fail — It means He remains your first love.

Yet I hold this against you: You have forsaken the love you had at first. Revelation 2:4 NIV

2. To Be Found Loving People Sacrificially

By this everyone will know that you are My disciples, if you love one another." John 13:35

3. To Be Found Living Purely

All who have this hope in him purify themselves, just as he is pure. 1 John 3:3 NIV

4. Found Doing His Work Faithfully

It will be good for that servant whose master finds him doing so when he returns. Matthew 24:46 NIV

There are also 3 things the Bible clearly says we should not be doing

1. Don't Be Found Sleeping Spiritually

And do this, understanding the present time: The hour has already come for you to wake up from your slumber, because our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed. Romans 13:11 NIV



How Will Jesus Find Me

2. Don't Be Found Living in Sin

Be careful, or your hearts will be weighed down with dissipation, drunkenness, and the anxieties of life, and that day will close on you suddenly like a trap." Luke 21:34 NIV

Living in Sin Is Different Than Struggling With Sin

3. Don't Be Found Distracted by the World

The worries of this life and the deceitfulness of wealth choke the word, making it unfruitful." Mathew 13:22 NIV
