This is a community service project, which means it requires volunteers to make it work. We perform 15 shows for about 700 -1200 people each year in two days (Friday and Saturday September 26-27). We will start puppet practice at 2 p.m. to give people a chance to eat lunch. With 3 services now, 8 a.m.; 9:30 a.m. and 11 a.m. that should give everyone a chance to eat. We will only practice from 2-3 p.m. It is necessary to train everyone in how to be a puppeteer. I need about 15 volunteers, and in the last couple of years it has been difficult to get new people because of the time commitment. When we have fewer volunteers, it really puts stress on those that are there because they have to do more parts in the show making it difficult (your arms get sore) to continue. The more people volunteering the better, but I cannot make you volunteer, it has to be a desire you have to serve others in the


