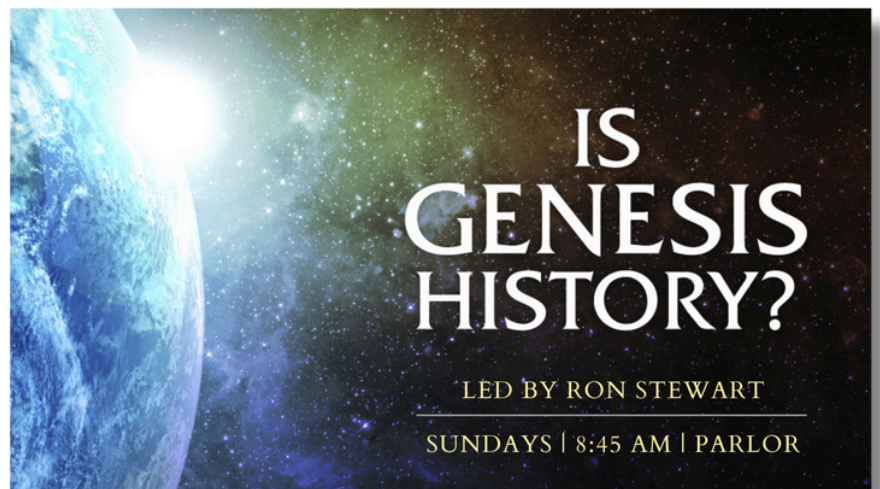
## New Adult Sunday School Study!

Starting December 21, Ron Stewart leads a new study during the Sunday School hour in the Parlor called "Inquiring Minds Want To Know: Is Genesis History?"

This study is based on the video series "Is Genesis History?" with the addition of "Evolution's Achilles' Heels," and printed resources. The course is presented in layman's terms from the perspective of a Ph.D. scientist who is also a Christian. We will discover and discuss the considerable volume of information that supports a Biblical view of creation. At the same time,

we will uncover some of the problems with today's form of "science" guided by paradigms and research funding. This class will give parents and others a basis for refuting the current educational paradigm of a godless world view.

"There are two primary paradigms of history: one defined by natural processes occurring slowly over billions of years, the other defined by recent, direct actions of God as recorded in the Bible." (Del Tackett). We will approach this subject through video presentations followed by discussion.
