

### A Message From the Session

If you remember, we used the Transitional Pastor process in our search for Pastor Dan Clark. Christopher Mathewson lead us through a church revitalization meeting; a Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, and Threats (S.W.O.T.) analysis; and a vision team. This resulted in a vision and mission statement and a plan to move forward. The next step was engaging with Fort Cherry School District where the door had opened to us. This would have involved mentoring students, after school programs, and other opportunities to meet community needs.

However, shortly after Pastor Dan arrived, we and the school district were shut down by COVID. Pastor Dan was then faced with the awesome task of keeping the church together, working through the resulting reduction in church giving, and other pressing issues. As we opened back up, Dan focused on getting us on board with the mission and vision we had adopted before he came and implementing a next step in discipleship by starting small group studies.

Further, we had to immediately improve and increase our electronic presence on the internet, FaceBook, and other venues to reach those who could not return to church. However, by now, the open door at the schools had closed.

After considerable discussion, Session decided that before we bring in a new pastor, revisit we need to implementation plans and decide where we are going. This will make the effort to find a pastor who is on board with us easier. So, we decided to bring in a Transitional Pastor to focus on identifying and implementing the next steps in our mission and vision. We believe that we do not need to repeat the earlier steps in the transitional process as described above.

The Transitional Pastor will also assist us in forming the Pastoral Search Committee, lead us through the search process for a permanent senior pastor, and, of course, preach, counsel, visit shut-ins, and officiate at baptisms, weddings, communion, and funerals. This will provide continuity until we fill the senior pastor position.

The Session has appointed Blake Grove, J.D. Little and Ron Stewart to serve as the Transitional Pastor Search Team. The team Worship: Sundays | 10:00 am


# A New Year in a New Role BY ASHLEY LEWIS

### REPORT CARD RESULT FINAL EXAMS

Distribution of end-of-year report cards this week. The school staff has been very busy these past two weeks preparing the report cards and re-registration at the same time. It was a monster job. They deserve credit for a job well done, because all the entities that make up the school - parents, students and teaching staff - are satisfied. We give glory to God for allowing us to achieve this goal in a very depressed and difficult social context. We owe our success to the support of people like you who have helped us. It has been so difficult, and your help has made it possible. We look forward to the start of the new school year in mid-September, God willing! This week is also marked by official exams. Many young students are on their way to take national exams. On our side, 32 young people are due to sit the national exams to mark the end of their high school careers, starting this week. We pray for their success. They have come a long way, but with determination and prayer they will succeed.

### MORE FOOD DISTRIBUTION IN THIS MONTH

Again at the beginning of August, we received a delivery of a food truck to the mission and immediately began distributing food. More than 600 families received food and next week more families will receive it. Glory be to God in heaven who has enabled us to serve these people. A big thank you to everyone who contributed so that these people could have this food. An important fact to mention is that when someone receives a bag of rice, he doesn't just eat with his family. If a neighbor doesn't receive a card inviting him to come to the mission, he shares the food with that person. That's a lot more than 600 families receiving food. So I will continue to pray for more grace, more blessings on each and every one of you who made this program possible.

### INTRODUCING A SPONSORED FAMILY

I'd like to introduce you to a lady who is the mother of a sponsored child. Her name is Yolene CHARLES. She comes from Platon, a mountainous region southeast of La Croix. She is the mother of 11 children, 7 of whom are still alive. Her husband no longer lives with her. She therefore plays the role of both father and mother. To look after her children, she goes to the market every Tuesday and Friday as a street vendor to try and sell what she used to cook at home.

She started this business in 2012. It was helping her with the children because things were going well. Today, her business is bankrupt, following a prolonged illness. And then there's the problem of insecurity in our beloved country of Haiti. This situation of insecurity persists. It has become much more difficult to go to the market at the moment, as gangs are confined to certain corners. In Platon, where she lives, people live at the mercy of the rain, like LaCroix. No water, no harvest. It's an almost inaccessible region, surrounded on either side by mountains. Many thanks to Pastor David and Cherrie MORGAN for choosing to sponsor two twins in this family, Jodlène and Jodler. Only God can reward you for what you do for them. Blessings!



### **VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL IN LACOUPE**

Two weeks ago there was VBS for the children in Lacroix. This week it is the turn of the children in Lacoupe. The children learn new things, listen to a Bible story, worship God, play together and have a hot meal. That's why we wanted this summer program, just to keep them in the mood to live together. Because we know that during holidays and vacations, these kids have no entertainment and nowhere to go.
