We want to invite you to be a guide and help our students navigate these questions. This method is designed for students to learn how to study the Bible so that they can adopt this method in their perosn a life.

## LEADER GUIDE WELCOME

Pastor Noah will present a "Wide Overview" of the text, offering definitions and supporting verses as resources.

After this, Study Groups will gather in their designated spaces with 25–35 minutes to work through the passage.

First Question: Introduce the question and allow students to begin sharing. This step helps them break sentences into key words and become familiar with the message.

Second Question: Students use their biblical knowledge, sermon notes, and the provided verse resources to form a biblical understanding of the text (not yet applying it personally).

Third Question: This question gives students the opportunity to insert the message into their personal life and see what area of life is moved.

After each Study Group, close with a time of prayer, giving students an opportunity to respond to God's movement!
