

# An Overcomer's Mindset

## Icebreaker:

Describe a time you felt overwhelmed by a “mountain” that stood in front of you.

## Discussion:

1) *What are some promises God has made the Church in his Word?*

**Revelation 12:11**

2) *If you are honest what thoughts of doubt or fear concerning those promises have crept in?*

3) *How do those doubts or fears impact your walk with God?*

**Numbers 13:27-29, 31-32**

4) *What does true faith look like?*

5) *How do you walk with the mindset of an overcomer?*

**I John 5:4-5; Psalm 108:13; Romans 8:37; Revelation 12:11**

## Edification:

- The doubts and fears you entertain paralyze your faith and leave your family and even your soul open for the enemy to walk in and take up residence.
- Thoughts of not being good enough, not being able to do what God has asked (though he promised it), or even outright unbelief that it could ever happen leave us in a space that causes God to label our beliefs as an “evil report”.
- True faith sees the Word of God as more than a self-help book. Rather it takes God at his word, believing if he said it, he will do it.
- Yet in the same breath true faith does not ask to consume for it's own desires, it simply believes the Word God has spoken and asks in accordance to His will.
- Overcomers see the same obstacles and circumstances as everyone else. The adversities, the perils, the hardships. Yet while everyone else looks through the lens of their flesh, their eyes can only see the possibilities of promise as they look through the lens of faith!
