

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LIFE

People helping people live out the unexpected love of Jesus every day.

The beginning of the year is a great time to think about reading Scripture. I have shared R.E.A.P. before—(1) get ready through planning a time and place and passage to read, (2) expect God to speak, (3) apply the Scripture to your life, and (4) turn what you read into a prayer. Is there a more specific series of steps, a magic method between the “E” and the “A,” that can help to overcome common obstacles to consistent Bible reading like busyness, confusion, and boredom?

Well... I do believe that there are helpful methods out there—from S.P.A.C.E.P.E.T.S. to guided studies like BSF. I have recently taught students the “7Ts”—What stands out to you? What is the text’s shape, its outline? What are its themes, terms that are repeated, related, rich, or rare? What is its thesis, the argument it makes? What is its theology, its vision of God? How would you teach this text? How can you turn it into prayer?

Whatever methods you use need to become second nature, like tools hanging in your mental garage that you pull out when a certain passage triggers them. I guess we are looking more for Bible reading “patterns” than “methods.” And if we are looking for patterns, one essential ingredient is commitment.

A pattern develops over time. When I became a Christian, I did not have specific steps beyond reading and praying. I remember reading the Bible through, searching for verses that would help me fight a sin, win an argument, provide comfort, etc. I kept reading the Bible, and what worked “stuck” in an organic way, evolving with my own personal development, circumstances, and training.

Since not reading was not an option, and since “necessity is the mother of invention,” I guess I invented! From this perspective, the scriptural strategies you employ are also survival strategies. If you absolutely must do a task, eventually you will learn to do it in a way that “works for you.” God refines it along the way. So yes, seek practical training. But before that, remember: God has inspired Scripture, and He wants to speak to you through it. Lord, renew this commitment in me!


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
