The idiom "Don't bet the ranch on that"; is a caution. To bet the ranch means to put all your resources, time, and effort into something with high stakes. The phrase originated when people would bet their entire farm or land as collateral for a loan. If they lost the bet, they would lose their property along with any other assets they had invested.

My seminary professors discussed reasons to believe in Christ and the ramifications if one did or did not. They did not like "Pascal's Wager" so much as other apologetics. However, that wager with some merit, is similar to our ranch idiom as a philosophical argument advanced by Blaise Pascal, a seventeenth-century French philosopher and theologian. His argument posits that individuals essentially engage in a life-defining gamble regarding the belief in the existence of God. Essentially Blaise said, if God does not exist, the faithful individual incurs only minimal and finite losses. However, if God does indeed exist, the faithful stand to gain immeasurably by an eternity in Heaven while simultaneously avoiding boundless losses associated with an eternal Hell. Christians know that it serves us well to "believe" (Eph 2:8-9). I propose, it is better to think of God's grace and our faith as gifts rather than as wagers, but we can agree there are high stakes involved here!

So today as believers, we find ourselves celebrating the resurrection of Christ. Christianity is fundamentally a resurrection faith of high stakes: "And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is worthless; you are still in your sins. Those, then, who have fallen asleep in Christ have also perished. If we have put our hope in Christ for this life only, we should be pitied more than anyone" (1 Cor 15:17-19). We should be pitied as fools if there is no resurrection when we have placed all our hopes in a falsehood. Heresies, apostasy, skepticism towards the supernatural elements of Scripture, and



modern "higher criticism" have failed to disprove the miraculous resurrection. Lives have changed! "He is risen!_____!" (fill it in).
