Are you feeling busy this morning? This past week, EHBC sent eight students and four sponsors to Worship4Life!, a week-long, musically-oriented leadership training camp. Next week, a few of us head to Las Vegas, NV, for missions. There's family life, home maintenance, and myriad daily duties. Doesn't that just sound...

Normal? It probably should. Tim Keller, in his book Every Good Endeavor, reminds us that work and other responsibilities are good and God-given, even though our labors are also complicated by the consequences of ancient and modern sin. So, a little hustle and bustle ought to be expected and is even something for which to be grateful. And yet...

You know the other side of the coin—rest. Pressing "pause." Of course, Jesus has fulfilled the sabbath commandment, meaning that he satisfied the law's righteous requirement on our behalf and has perfected the commandment to its original, divine intent. Crucified with him, the law of Moses was buried and raised the law of Christ—totally transformed, the same yet not the same as what is was before (Col 2:14; 1 John 2:7–8). As with the commands against adultery and murder, the sabbath leads us to look inward and outward.

As such, the question is not merely whether we set aside a day for rest (though that, as Bill preached some months ago, is an excellent practice). Now, the questions are whether our hearts rest in Jesus daily (Rom 14:5; Heb 4:9) and whether we extend this restful restoration to others (Mark 2:23–3:6). "He who makes haste with his feet misses his way" (Prov 19:2). And not just "his way," it is possible to miss God himself. Like C. S. Lewis said—

"In our own time and place avoiding God is extremely easy. Avoid silence, avoid solitude, avoid any train of thought that leads off the beaten track. Concentrate on money, sex, status, health and (above all) on your own grievances. Keep the radio on." Thank God for work. Seek God in rest.
