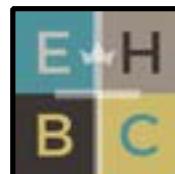

# LIFE

*People helping people live out the unexpected love of Jesus every day.*

My last couple of articles here in the LIFE have started covering a look at the Outcome Expressions that we considered when we took our church survey back in March during our vision framing process with Auxano. My article on May 25 looked at our five Outcome questions, and then on June 29, I considered the five Outcome expressions for the first question. Our second Outcome question asks, "How am I learning to see myself, others, and circumstances as God does?" This is a great question! It calls us to pause in the midst of things like criticism, conflict, and chaos and reflect on what God might be doing or saying through those things or people. The five Outcome expression statements that go with this question are:

- I know God's Word and character well enough to distinguish between His voice and other things I hear or think.
- When I listen to a sermon or read the Bible, my first instinct is to apply it to myself rather than to others.
- I am aware of areas where I need heart transformation and have specific next steps to pursue godly help and healing in those areas.
- I choose to respond with curiosity and compassion, instead of judgment, toward those I disagree with.
- My choices this week reveal that my identity comes from Christ alone—not from myself, my accomplishments, or what others might think.

Each of these questions helps us to evaluate things like our motives, our focus, our responses, and even our sin. The author of Hebrews writes: "Therefore, since we also have such a large cloud of witnesses surrounding us, let us lay aside every hindrance and the sin that so easily ensnares us. Let us run with endurance the race that lies before us, keeping our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of our faith...For consider him who endured such hostility from sinners against himself, so that you won't grow weary and give up." (Heb. 12:1-2a, 3, CSB) These questions help us evaluate whether we're really "keeping our eyes on Jesus:" listening to Him, imitating Him, and defining our identity in Him.
