People helping people live out the unexpected love of Jesus every day.

Communication is tough. See, we all communicate, however, most times we just communicate poorly. We don't listen to the other person's thoughts or words; we try to superimpose our thoughts or ideology onto another. We communicate our hurts by in turn hurting others. Some even weave a tapestry of sarcasm and passive aggressiveness into our communication.

When Kerry and I encounter this in our marriage or during counseling sessions with other couples, we will lean into the idea that encouragement and humility in communication will be more effective and Christ honoring. Let's learn from Paul about encouraging words.

Paul's travels kept him on the move, but his heart always remained with the churches he planted. His letters of encouragement still strengthen us today.

"I thank my God in all my remembrance of you, always offering prayer with joy in my every prayer for you all!" Phil 1:3,4

Paul encouraged, corrected, and guided believers through his writing. His letters weren't abstract theology—they were deeply personal. He cared about people's growth, their struggles, and their faith in Jesus.

"Therefore encourage one another and build up one another, just as you also are doing." 1 Thes 5:11

Encouragement is one of the most powerful gifts we can give. It costs nothing but can lift a weary heart or spark hope in someone ready to give up. Imagine where your marriage, or family relationship, working relationship would be if you took time to share a word of encouragement to another?

Paul pastored from afar, but his words became timeless encouragement for us. In the same way, our words—whether text, email, or face-to-face—carry power to strengthen others in their walk with Christ.

Here's a challenge for each of us, send a message of encouragement to someone in your life today. Share a verse, a prayer, or simply remind them that they're not alone.

Speak life, speak truth and encourage another this week.

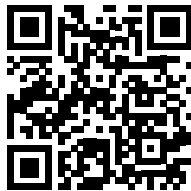
