LIFE

People helping people live out the unexpected love of Jesus every day.

This is my fifth article for the LIFE in what will be a series of six total, looking at our Outcomes and Outcome Expressions that were formed as part of our Vision Framing plan. These articles have appeared in the LIFE on May 25, June 29, July 27, and August 17.

Our fourth core value is PRACTICAL IMPACT: We seek to meet the needs of our neighbors wherever we find them. Given that we've been studying the Gospel of Luke this year, we shall not approach this statement like the expert in the law in Luke 10:29: "And who is my neighbor?" We know that our neighbors are everywhere and anywhere we are. Like our other core values, this one is both informational (an important characteristic of our DNA), and aspirational (something that we want to become). The folks of Eastern Hills often serve our neighbors, and we should strive to do so all the more.

This core value is the one most closely connected to our fourth Outcome question, which asks, "How are my hands open for God's use today?" Take a look at your hands. Go ahead, I'll wait... Done? Great... The truth is that God gave you those hands, and He wants you to use them for His purposes for His glory. So are your hands open for God to use today, or are they closed? This is a posture that God Himself has, according to the psalmist: "You open Your hand and satisfy the desire of every living thing." (Psalm 145:16)

Our five Outcome expression statements that flesh out this fourth Outcome question are:

- My answer is "Yes" even before I know what God may ask me to do.
- I build enough margin into my day to respond to the people and opportunities God brings to me.
- I can name specific ways I am using my skills and spiritual gifts to serve people inside and outside the church.
- I cheerfully give a sacrificial amount of my income to the church to glorify God and invest in His kingdom work.
- I believe the purpose of the church is not to provide activities I like, but to spur me to love and reach others.

Take another look at your hands. Are they open? Or closed?

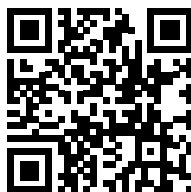
