



Several weeks ago, it was time for me to prepare my Sunday morning Bible study lesson. The title of the lesson was: God's Care, Psalm 23. Right away I was thinking, "Wow, what a familiar passage...". At the same time, the version of the Bible that I was familiar with since childhood was the KJV, and the study guide version was the CSB. I struggled to prepare the lesson because the different translation of the 23rd Psalm didn't sound or "feel" right. After all, everyone knows the KJV, "The LORD is my Shepherd, I shall not want," but the CSB says, "The LORD is my Shepherd, I have what I need." I had to stop and ask the Lord to help me as I struggled with preconceived ideas and to help me listen to the truths being revealed by David's inspiration of the Holy Spirit. I fell in love with the CSB version too!

In Christ, we have all that we need and that is both spiritually and physically. Our salvation is by God's grace through faith in Jesus who is the Good Shepherd (Eph. 2:8-9, John 10).
