

"Follow me, and I will make you fishers of men" (Matthew 4:19). As you probably know, these are the words Jesus used to inaugurate the journey of discipleship for people like Andrew, Simon Peter, James, John, and (consequentially), for people like you and me. Based on this verse, we learn that discipleship is relational, transformational, and missional (many thanks to my brother-in-law Kurt Shiver, who does college ministry in Florida, for these points).

First, discipleship is relational. This is the "follow me" of Matthew 4:19, the "come and see" of John 1:39 (see also First Thessalonians 2:8). You cannot disciple people unless you are willing to spend time with people. Conversely, if you are willing to spend time with people, you are able to disciple them, no matter how inadequate you feel!

Second, discipleship is transformational. "I will make you," Jesus says, describing a metamorphosis in which our relationship with Jesus leads to profound changes in our character. Some of these changes are organically caught, and some are programmatically taught (see Second Timothy 3:16-17, Romans 12:1-2, and First Thessalonians 5:14).

Third and finally, discipleship is missional. "Fishers of men." Because Jesus rose, his mission continues. He invites us to continue that mission in the power of the Spirit (John 20:21).

Our church recognizes these three dimensions of disciplemaking. Consider the EHBC KIDS motto: "Know Jesus. Live Like Jesus. Make Jesus Known." It's relational, transformational, and missional. This is also the logic of our core values—authentic family and real truth lead to genuine growth and practical impact.

These dimensions of discipleship might also shape your prayer this morning: Lord, thank you for calling me to be your disciple. Please help me to know you better, and give me genuine friendships with other people who also hunger to know you. Please help me to be humble, obedient, and worshipful—holy and loving like you are holy and loving. If I have learned any lessons or Christian life hacks, help me take opportunities to share those with others.
