

Let's be real—serving people in need isn't always convenient. In fact, it rarely is.

Think about Jesus washing His disciples' feet in John 13. This was the night before His crucifixion. He could have been focused on His coming suffering. Instead, He got down on His knees, took the posture of a servant, and washed dusty feet.

"So if I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet." John 13:14

True service often costs something—time, comfort, even pride. And that's the point. Service is sacrificial love in action.

Ithink back to a family we knew who spent Christmas morning serving breakfast at a homeless shelter. Honestly, I thought it was extreme—who gives up Christmas morning? But the mom said, "It's the one day they need to feel most remembered." That stuck with me. Their sacrifice wasn't glamorous. It didn't make the news. But it mirrored Jesus—choosing others over self.

Our mission statement is "People helping people live out the unexpected love of Jesus every day." When we serve with a sacrificial love, we display the unexpected love of Jesus.

Serving, whether it's inside the walls of EHBC or outside the walls, interrupts our schedules. It pushes us outside our comfort zones. But that's where God's love shows up most clearly. It's where people see Jesus in us—not because we're impressive, but because we're willing to kneel. Again, we are living out the unexpected love of Jesus!

Here's my challenge, nay, my encouragement: Sacrifice something this week-time, comfort, or resources-to serve someone in need. Maybe it's buying a meal for a neighbor in need, volunteering, or simply listening when you'd rather rush. Whatever it is, do it unto the Lord in worship and love.
