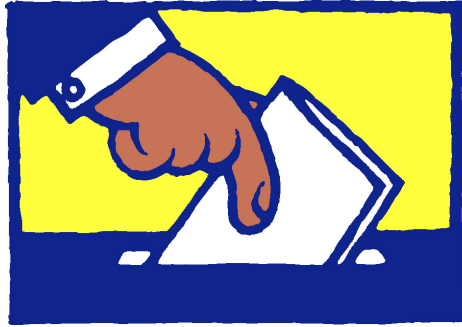
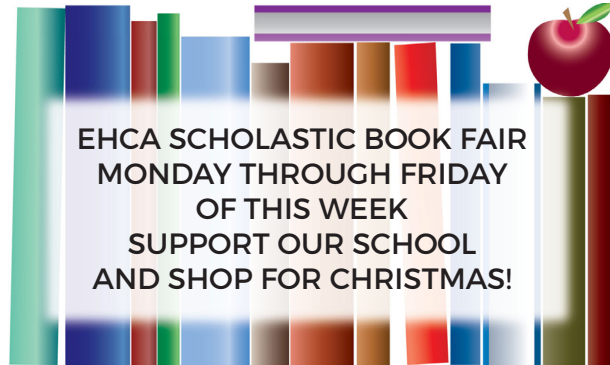

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LIFE

People helping people live out the unexpected love of Jesus every day.

Let me ask you this, "Have you ever felt overwhelmed by intrusive thoughts—those persistent, unwanted ideas or fears that seem to barge in uninvited?" It can feel like a battle raging in your mind, stealing your peace and focus. But as followers of Christ, we are not left to fight this battle alone. God's Word equips us with a powerful strategy to confront and overcome these thoughts.

Replace your "what if" thoughts with gratitude for what truly is.

In Philippians 4:6-8, Paul offers wisdom that can begin to transform our hearts.

"Don't worry about anything, but in everything, through prayer and petition with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus."

The first step in combating intrusive thoughts is to replace worry with prayer. When your mind feels overwhelmed, take those thoughts to God in prayer. Lay them at His feet and trust that He cares deeply for you. Pair your prayers with thanksgiving, shifting your focus from what troubles you to what God has already done for you. Gratitude can redirect your mind toward hope and faith.

Paul continues in verse 8:

"Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable—if there is any moral excellence and if there is anything praiseworthy—dwell on these things."

When intrusive thoughts attack, challenge them by asking: Is this true? Is this noble? Is this aligned with God's Word? Then intentionally replace those thoughts with ones that reflect God's goodness and truth. Dwell on those truths.

The peace of God is not something we earn; it is a gift He gives when we trust Him and realign our thoughts with His. As you face the battles of the mind, remember that God's Spirit is with you, ready to guard your heart and mind in Christ Jesus.

Praying that He fills your mind with His peace, truth, and goodness.
