# LIFE

People helping people live out the unexpected love of Jesus every day.

In First Corinthians chapter 15, the apostle Paul wants to make clear that the resurrection of Jesus is essential to the gospel. It is the same message that he preached in Corinth and everywhere he went, but there were other people who denied the resurrection of Christ.

Paul knew that he had to expose this false doctrine and correct it immediately. First Corinthians 15:3-8 contains a clear and concise summation of the gospel; it is easy to understand, and it corrects any false teaching that has crept into the church. Paul reminds the Corinthian believers that this is the same message he passed on to them resulting in their salvation. The remainder of the chapter continues to emphasize that Jesus' resurrection is crucial to our faith, or it is all in vain. Also, Paul shared, "But as it is, Christ has been raised from the dead" (15:20) explaining that this guarantees our resurrection by which we will be "raised in glory," "raised in power," and "raised a spiritual body" (42-44). Christ gives us the victory because He conquered our sin and death, "But thanks be to God who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ" (15:57).

Even today, there are those who deny the truth of the gospel, or people try to add to or take away from the message. It is imperative that Christians stand firm upon the truth of God's word. As the scripture says, "Therefore, my dear brothers and sisters, be steadfast, immovable, always excelling in the Lord's work, because you know that your labor is not in vain" (15:58). So, as the saying goes, "Keep on keeping on" with a grateful heart, steadfast, and committed to sharing the truth of the gospel of Christ, the same message passed on to us, resulting in our salvation, and all to the glory of God.

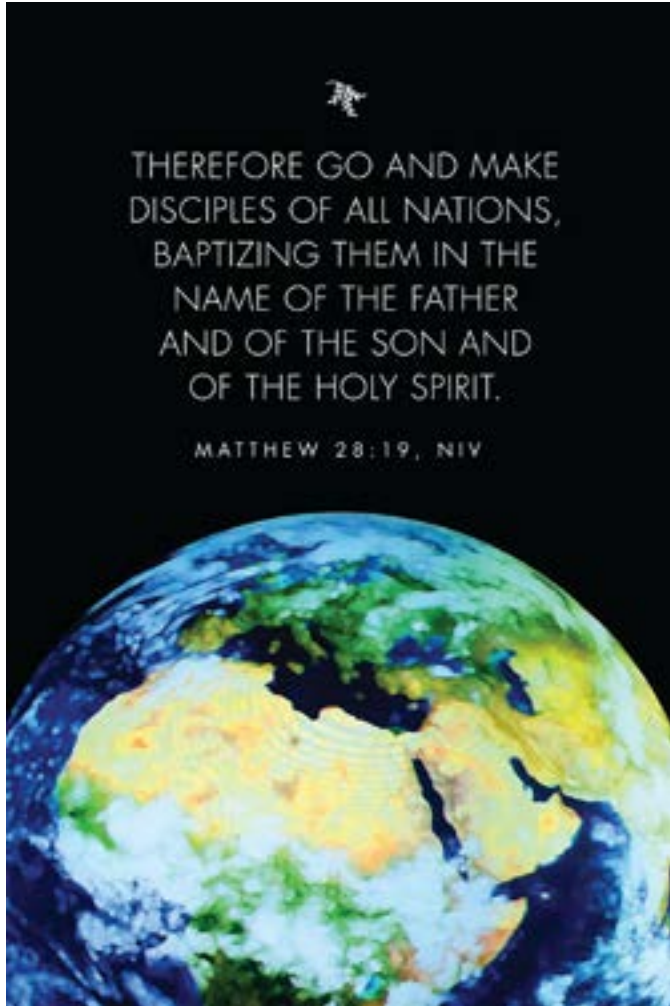
