











LIFE

People helping people live out the unexpected love of Jesus every day.

In Luke 2:8-20, we read about the shepherds in the fields outside the city of Bethlehem keeping watch at night over their flock. Suddenly, an angel of the Lord stood before them, the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified. I can only imagine the shock and surprise of it all, including the angel saying, "Don't be afraid." The angel continues to say, "I proclaim to you good news of great joy that will be for all the people: Today in the city of David a Savior was born for you, who is the Messiah, the Lord. This will be sign for you: You will find a baby wrapped tightly in cloth and lying in a manger" (verses 10-12). Then another surprise. Suddenly a multitude of heavenly host joins the angel praising God and saying, "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and peace on earth to people He favors" (verses 13,14).

After the angels left the shepherds, darkness would have returned in an abrupt silence. They then decide to go straight to Bethlehem to see what God has revealed to them, and they find Mary and Joseph and the baby lying in the manager just like the sign given to them earlier. After seeing the Savior who was born, the shepherds began to tell everyone "the message they were told about this child and all who heard it were amazed at what the shepherds said to them" (verses 17,18). As the shepherds returned to their flocks, they worshiped glorifying and praising God for everything "they had seen and heard, which were just as they had been told" (verse 20).


When we worship by singing **The First Noel** ("noel" means "born"), we are proclaiming the birth of Jesus who is our Savior, glorifying God's amazing love revealed to us. This is like the message the shepherds share with everyone about the good news of boundless joy that is for all people because He is Messiah, the Savior of all people. So, let us continue to share about God's amazing love, the good news of the gospel of Christ, and why we celebrate Christmas.
