Bible Studies for Life (Marcos Crespo, Sr.)

This class is designed to help adult groups make disciples through comprehensive, in-depth Bible study. Each year, this series addresses the eight spiritual markers found in maturing believers to ensure that participants are getting a balanced approach to discipleship.

This summer studies include:

- Risk Takers: The Adventure of Walking by Faith Though exercising our faith can feel risky, see that the GOD we follow turns it into a grand adventure when we place our trust in HIM (6 sessions)
- Character Counts Since our character is to match the ONE we profess to follow, consider the character traits that are critical in the life of every believer (6 sessions).

Devoted – Bible Reading & Discussion (Russ Daubert & Ken Dreistadt)

This is a continued class that uses the Bible as their text, so no other book needs to be ordered. Newcomers are always welcome to start at any time.

Finishing Well – Living with Purpose in the Final Third of Life (Dan Dougherty)

With longer life expectancy comes a new opportunity: the chance to live with purpose, faith, and joy in the later chapters of life. Based on 'Finishing Well' by John Goodale, this Sunday School class is designed for adults 50 and older who want to be intentional about how they live the years still before them. Together, we will explore fourteen biblical accounts that offer insight into what it means to 'finish well' – not just growing older, but growing deeper in faith, character, and impact. Each week will include Scripture-based teaching, real-life examples, reflection questions, and practical steps to help us:

- Leave behind a legacy that honors GOD
- Embrace gratitude and contentment
- Serve with wisdom and joy
- Face transitions and challenges with grace
- Deepen our walk with CHRIST in every season

Filled with stories, humor, and meaningful discussion, this class offers a fresh and inspiring look at the final third of life – not as a time of winding down, but of spiritual growth and renewed purpose. Come be a part of a journey that celebrates life, faith, and finishing well.
