DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Paul points to the privileged position of Israel, who grew up with God's Word, the Temple, and many rabbis and teachers. How does being in the Church (and raising our children in the Church) give us an advantage where the Gospel is concerned?
- 2. Even as the above is TRUE, Paul shows that while hearing the Gospel is a condition for believing, it is NOT a guarantee. Faith is still necessary. The Jews heard the Gospel proclaimed (through the Old Testament, and through Paul and other teachers), yet only a **REMNANT** believed. How does this truth challenge you in your own faith journey and as you consider your children and/or family?
- 3. The hope for the world is that God does not give up on 'disobedient and obstinate people". He continues to reach for them, and He calls the Church to do the same. How are you personally trying to witness to "Jerusalem, Samaria, and the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8)? What does that look like for you?
