Prayer gives you the opportunity to come together with your church family and communicate with God on one accord to bring about a mighty change in your life and in our surrounding communities.





01.

SELF CONTROL

"....For a man is a slave to whatever controls him" (II Peter 2:19 LB). "Even if we believe that it makes no difference to the Lord whether we do these things, still we cannot just go ahead and do them to please ourselves; for we must bear the burden of being considerate of the doubts and fears of others – of those who feel these things are wrong. Let's please the other fellow, not ourselves, and do what is for his good and thus build him up in the Lord" (Romans 15:2-3 LB).

Those who live immoral lives, who are idol worshipers, adulterers or homosexuals will have no share in his Kingdom..." (I Corinthians 6:9 LB).

"But now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is called a brother be a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolater, or a railer, or a drunkard, or an extortioner, with such a one do not to eat" (I Corinthians 5:11 LB).

02.

<u>DRUNKENNESS /</u> DRUGS

"Don't drink too much wine, for many evils lie along that path; be filled instead with the Holy Spirit, and controlled by Him" (Ephesians 5:18 LB). "For the drunkard and the glutton shall come to poverty; and drowsiness shall clothe a man with rags" (Proverbs 23:21) "Envy, murder, drunkenness, wild parties, and all that sort of thing. Let me tell you again as I have before, that anyone living that sort of life will not inherit the Kingdom of God" (Galatians 5:21 LB). "Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God" (I Corinthians 6:10 LB).

03.

SMOKING

"Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you? If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy, for the temple of God is holy, which temple are ye" (I Corinthians 3:16-17). "Haven't you yet learned that your body is the home of the Holy Spirit God gave you, and that He lives within you? Your body does not belong to you. For God has bought you with a great price. So use every part of your body to give glory back to God, because He owns it" (I Corinthians 6:19).

04.

HOMOSEXUALITY

"You shall not lie with a man as with a woman; it is an abomination" (Leviticus 18:22). "...God let go of them and let them do all these evil things, so that even their women turned against God's natural plan for them and indulged in sex sin with each other. Romans 1:18-32

05.

THE TONGUE

The tongue is such a small member of the body but has a potent power. The tongue not only affects your life but the lives of others - especially those in which you speak on. Your tongue locates where you are; "for out of the heart the tongue speaks." (James 3:1-17; James 4:1-17; James 5:13-20)

06.

PERSONAL ETHICS

You can do anything you want to do because you have freewill. However, all things aren't good for you; even if you're allowed to do them. You must be careful that the wrong things do not get such a grip on you that you can't easily stop when needed. We can always prove that we are right, but is the Lord convinced? Proverbs. 16:2 All the ways of a man are pure in his own eyes, but the Lord weighs the spirits.

07.

<u>OBEDIENCE TO</u> LAW

"Obey the government, for God is the one who has put it there. There is no government anywhere that
God has not placed in power. So those who refuse to obey the laws of the land are refusing to obey God, and punishment will follow" (Romans 13:1-2 LB). "Obey the laws, then, for two reasons: first to keep from being punished, and second, just because you know you should and you want to please God".

08.

<u>FAMILY /</u> HOUSEHOLD

God created the family to be the strongest unit on the face of the earth. It is by the family that we understand the authority of God, the love of God, and even the discipline of God. It is my belief that the enemy is out to destroy the family unit, because if the family is destroyed, our communities, churches and even our ability to relate to God will be negatively affected.

09.

<u>THE MARRIAGE</u> <u>UNION</u>

God designed marriage to be between one man and one woman. Ephesians 5:30-31 For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones. For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined to his wife and they two shall be one flesh.

Conduct with Others

01.

THE HUSBAND

Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave Himself up for her, so that He might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the Word. That He might present the church to himself in glorious splendor, without spot or wrinkle of any such things (that she might be holy and faultless). Even so husbands should love their wives as (being in a sense) their own bodies. He who loves his own wife loves himself.

02.

THE WIFE

Wives, be subject (be submissive and adapt yourselves) to your own husbands as [a service] to the Lord. For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the Head of the church, Himself the Savior of His body. As the church is subject to Christ, so let wives also be subject in everything to their husbands. Eph 5:22-24 AMP

03.

THE PARENTS

And now a word to you parents. Don't keep on scholding and nagging your children, making them angry and resentful. Rather bring them up with the loving discipline the Lord Himself apporves, Col 3:21 LB. Train up a child in the way that he should go; and when he is old, he will not depart from it. Pro 22:6

04.

CHILDREN

"Honor your father and mother, that you may have a long, good life in the land the Lord your God will give you" (Exodus 20:12). Children, obey your parents; this is the right thing to do because God has placed them in authority over you. Honor your father and mother. This is the first of God's ten commandments that ends with a promise. And this is the promise if you honor your father and mother; yours will be a long life, full of blessing (Ephesians 6:1-3 LB).

05.

NEIGHBOR

Galatians 5:22 gives us a clear guideline in our conduct with others. When love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness and temperance are your guiding principles you'll relate to others as God desires for His children to relate to others. Also read: Leviticus 19:9-18; Mark 12:30,31.

Week Five

I'm Saved, Now What?

01.

FORGIVENES AND LOVE

Forgiveness of Love. Ephesians 4:30 (NKJ) and be kind to one another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God in Christ forgave you. Forgiveness is a mandate from God and is not an option without a consequence. Jesus taught the disciples that they must forgive if they wanted to receive forgiveness. Matthew 6:12-15

Forgiveness is to be unlimited. Luke 17:3-5; Matthew 18:21-22

02.

HOLY COMMUNION

The Lord's Supper (Communion). When He had given thanks, He broke it and said this is my body in which is broken for you. Do this in remembrance of me. In the same way also the cup, after supper, saying this cup is the new covenant in my blood... (I Corinthians 11:24 -25, 28)

04.

<u>INFILLING OF HOLY</u> <u>SPIRIT</u>

The baptism of Holy Spirit is the promise of the Father. All believers are entitled to, and should ardently expect & earnestly seek, the promise of the Father. The Baptism in the Holy Ghost and Fire, according to the command of our Lord Jesus Christ. This was the normal experience in the early Christian church.

When it comes to the endowment of power for life and service, the bestowing of the gifts and their uses in the work of the ministry (Luke 24:49; Acts 1:4-8; I Corinthians 12:1-31). This wonderful experience is distinct from the subsequent to the experience of the new birth (Acts 2:38; 10:44- 46; 11:14-26; 15:7-9).

03.

BAPTISM

The ordinance of baptism by a burial with Christ should be observed as commanded in the Scriptures by all that have really repented and in their hearts have truly believed in Christ as Savior and Lord. In so doing, they declare to the world that they have died with Jesus and that they have also been raised with Him to walk in newness of life. (Matthew 28:19; Acts 10:47, 48; Romans 6:4).

As those who have accepted Jesus as Savior, our desire should be to follow Jesus and be like Him. Jesus was baptized in water by John, according to Matthew 3:16; which is the act of being immersed in water. This passage highlights the importance of baptism:

- Baptism in water is an outward act that shows our inward experience that Jesus washed away our sins.
- Baptism is a public way of showing people that we have made Jesus our Lord and we are joining the Body of Christ.
- Baptism is only for those who have repented of sin and believe in the Lord Jesus Christ as Jesus taught this (Mat- thew 28:19, Mark 16:16) while the Church did this (Acts 2:41, 8:12, 8:36-38, 9:17-18, 10:47-48, 16:14-15, 16:31-34, 18:8 and 19:4-5).
- Baptism is a picture of death and life. Jesus commanded it (Matthew 28:19): "Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit."
- Baptism is for those who have made a decision to accept Jesus as their personal Savior by repenting of sin and asking Him into their lives. Acts 2:38 Repent and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of sins.
