<u>Tuesday, April 14, 2026</u> Meet at 6:15 am to board the coach at *First United Methodist Church Fox Hill*, 1 Salt Pond Road, Hampton, VA 23669. Depart for Asheville, NC with quick breakfast, lunch, and rest stops. Upon arrival we'll check in to <u>Country Inn & Suites Asheville River Arts District</u> for our overnight stay. Wednesday, April 15, 2026 We begin our day with breakfast at the hotel before checking out and



boarding our coach for the short ride to The Biltmore Estate. Experience "America's Largest Home", as magnificent today as it was more than a century ago. We'll begin with a self-guided audio house tour and free time to explore the gardens. The visit spans three floors and the basement of the luxurious family home of George and Edith Vanderbilt. Also included will be

time at Antler Hill Village for some wine


tasting (first come, first served). We'll have lunch on our own and travel onward to Chattanooga, TN where we will check in to Spring Hill Suites Chattanooga Downtown for our two night stay.

Thursday, April 16, 2026 We begin our busy day with breakfast at the hotel. Next, we'll board our coach with a step-on guide for a terrific tour of Chattanooga and the area. Our agenda includes Ruby Falls, At 145 feet high and 1,120 feet underground, Ruby Falls is the tallest and deepest underground waterfall open to the public in the United States. Take a 260-foot glass elevator down, followed by a guided tour on paved paths with some stairs all at a consistent 60°F year-round. Other destinations today include Lookout Mountain Incline Railway, Rock City Gardens



(with a box lunch), and National Medal of Honor Heritage Center. We'll drop off our guide prior to dinner at Rodizio Grill where we will enjoy the tradition of Brazilian Gauchos carving rotisserie-grilled meats tableside, with unlimited Brazilian Sides and Gourmet Salads. Following dinner, we'll head 30 miles north to Cleveland, TN, for *Hello, Dolly!* presented by the drama department of Lee University. Friday, April 17, 2026 Following our hotel breakfast, we'll check out before our guide joins us to continue our Chattanooga touring. Our destinations include Chickamauga & Chattanooga National Military

Park which covers nearly 10,000 acres in the Chattanooga, TN region. In 1863, Union and Confederate forces fought for control of Chattanooga, known as the "Gateway to the Deep South." The Confederates had a



September victory in nearby Chickamauga, but renewed fighting in Chattanooga that November provided Union troops victory and control of the city. Next, we'll arrive at <u>Tennessee Valley Railway Museum</u> and train ride. Step back in time to a slower-paced era when railroad travel was a way of life. The TVRM provides an interactive, historical experience. Here you will find the only regularly scheduled, full-sized train ride in Tennessee; a chance to experience the sights and sounds of yesteryear! Afterward, we'll have a Jason's Deli boxed lunch and head to Pigeon Forge, TN for **Dolly Patton's Stampede and Dinner.** This world-class attraction

is known as a family tradition. Enjoy a high-spirited adventure featuring thrilling equestrian challenges, aerial performances, musical productions, and more. Shortly after taking our seats in the 36,000 square foot arena, we'll be served a four-course meal: the Stampede's famous creamy vegetable soup, a buttery biscuit, a whole rotisserie chicken, hickory-smoked pulled pork, buttery corn on the cob, homestyle mashed potatoes, and the Stampede's signature dessert! After dinner and the show, we check-in to the nearby Holiday Inn Express & Suites, Kodak, TN for a good night's sleep. (TripAdvisor.com rating 4.5 out of 5) (B, L, D)
