#### Preparing Your Testimony

As part of baptism preparation, each candidate reflects on and shares their personal story of coming to faith in Jesus Christ. This follows the encouragement of the Apostle Peter, who wrote: "Always be prepared to give an answer to anyone who asks you for the reason for the hope that is in you" (1 Peter 3:15).

Every Christian has a story of God's grace—how Jesus has met us, forgiven us, and made us His own. Sharing that story is not only a way to prepare for baptism; it is also a celebration of God's work in your life and a way of joining in the Church's witness to His love.

This testimony exercise has two purposes in the baptism process:


- 1. Preparation It helps you reflect on your journey with Christ and be ready to share your faith clearly and joyfully.
