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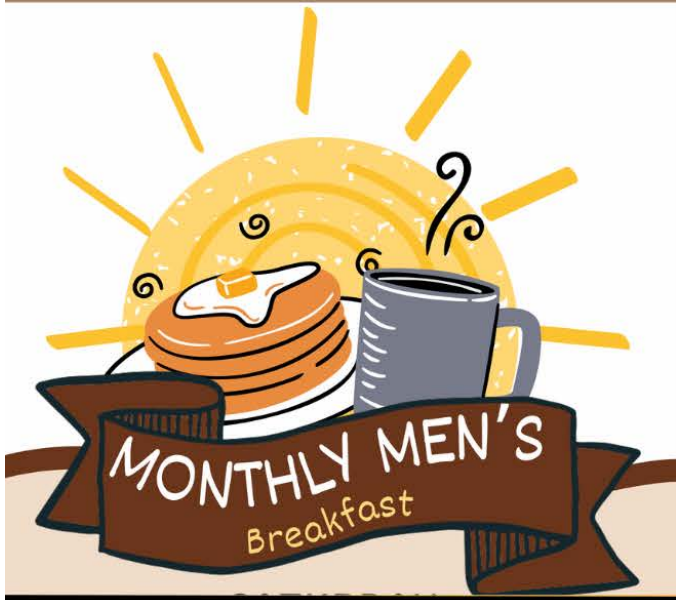

This includes earthquakes, famines, plagues, and wars. Haggerty's best friend, Caleb believes these are events leading to the Rapture.

Haggerty has enough stress in his life, but he's never gotten over the grief of his divorce. His ex-wife is his one true love. He misses the family he once had and tries to maintain a relationship with his daughter who is reaching adulthood. Personal and professional situations are pushing him to the brink.
