The River of Healing - Ezekiel 47:1-12

Ezekiel 47:1-12 describes a vision of a river of life flowing from God's Temple, which brings healing and abundance to the land. The water starts as a trickle, progressively deepening to an impassable river. This spiritual river symbolizes the Holy Spirit and the transformative power of the Gospel, bringing life to barren places and bearing fruit for nourishment healing.

Ezekiel 47:1-12 NLT

1 In my vision, the man brought me back to the entrance of the Temple. There I saw a stream flowing east from beneath the door of the Temple and passing to the right of the altar on its south side. **2** The man brought me outside the wall through the north gateway and led me around to the eastern entrance. **There I could see the water flowing out through the south side of the east gateway.** **3** Measuring as he went, he took me along the stream for 1,750 feet^[a] and then led me across. **The water was up to my ankles.** **4** He measured off another 1,750 feet and led me across again. This time **the water was up to my knees.** After another 1,750 feet, **it was up to my waist.** **5** Then he measured another 1,750 feet, and **the river was too deep to walk across. It was deep enough to swim in, but too deep to walk through.** **6** He asked me, “Have you been watching, son of man?” Then he led me back along the riverbank. **7** When I returned, I was surprised by the sight of many trees growing on both sides of the river. **8** Then he said to me, “This river flows east through the desert into the valley of the Dead Sea.^[b] **The waters of this stream will make the salty waters of the Dead Sea fresh and pure.** **9** There will be swarms of living things wherever the water of this river flows.^[c] Fish will abound in the Dead Sea, for its waters will become fresh. **Life will flourish wherever this water flows.** **10** Fishermen will stand along the shores of the Dead Sea. All the way from En-ge-di to En-eglaim, the shores will be covered with nets drying in the sun. Fish of every kind will fill the Dead Sea, just as they fill the Mediterranean.^[d] **11** But the marshes and swamps will not be purified; they will still be salty. **12** Fruit trees of all kinds will grow along both sides of the river. The leaves of these trees will never turn brown and fall, and there will always be fruit on their branches. There will be a new crop every month, for they are watered by the river flowing from the Temple. The fruit will be for food and the leaves for healing.”

- **The Gospel** - The river's growth from a small stream into a vast river represents the gospel message that began in a humble way but expanded to cover the earth.
- **God's Blessings** - The abundance and life that the river brings symbolize God's overflowing grace, mercy, and love that transform lives and create spiritual fertility.
- **Spiritual Journey** - The increasing depths of the river illustrate that a deeper relationship with God brings greater experiences of His presence and power.
- **The Kingdom of God** - The vision provides a glimpse of the renewed and revitalized world in the coming Kingdom of Jesus Christ, where the tree of life offers healing and sustenance to all. (We are that Tree of Life (Psalms 1 and Isaiah 61:3))

Psalm 1:3 - And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper

Isaiah 61:3 - To appoint unto them that mourn in Zion, to give unto them beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness; that they might be called **trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that he might be glorified.**
