After Friday night football games, our youth have been gathering for 5th Quarter events—an incredible blend of games, devotionals, and connection.

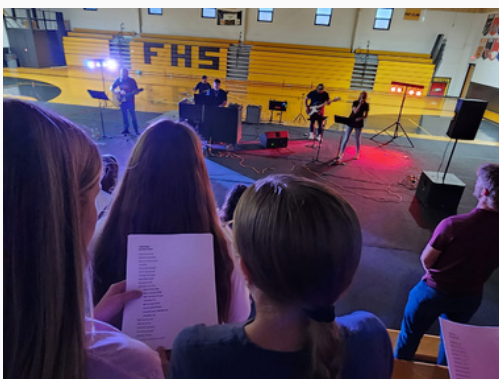
- August 29: We kicked off the season with 26 students jumping into a lively game of kickball. Around 40 students joined us in total, making it a great night of fun and friendship.
