Forgiveness-Human vs. Divine By Ted Kober: What else distinguishes biblical forgiveness? With God's forgiveness, I have been declared not guilty. "There is therefore now no

Reconciliation guilty. "There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus" (Romans 8:1). My sins have been washed away. God no longer views me as sinful but as holy. "For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God" (2 Corinthians 5:21). Counselors tell clients that forgiving others brings inner peace. They advise forgiving for personal healing. Although forgiveness benefits the forgiver, the primary reason a Christian forgives is not for personal therapy. He forgives because he has benefited from Christ's forgiveness. Peace does not come from our own actions, but from Christ. "Therefore, since we

have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ" (Romans 5:1).
